

MASS INTENTIONS :

On March 20, Bishop Lucia sent a letter to all Pastors reminding us of the regulations regarding the number of intentions which can be offered at one Mass. In Church Law the norm is one (1) intention per Mass.

I have been allowing five (5) intentions per Mass for several years.

In 1991 the Vatican granted a special privilege that allowed:

- 3 Intentions can be linked at one Mass
- This privilege can only be used twice per week at each parish
- A "Mass for the People of the Parish" must be offered weekly

The Bishop directed us to bring our policies into conformity with Church Law as soon as possible. He also stated the **all Masses already in the books will be honored.**

Going forward when you request a Mass:

- If there are no openings on a requested day, your intention will be recorded in a special book for "Mass Intentions"
- They will be used in your home Parish if a day becomes available
- After one year, any Mass requests which have not been honored will be sent to the Office of Priest Personnel, which will distribute them to retired priests, parishes in need of intentions and priests in the Missions
- Our sacred oath to you is that when you request a Mass it will be offered for your intention by an individual priest.

To be fair, and to accommodate all of the families in our 3 parishes: If you call and ask for several Masses (different people, anniversaries, birthdays, etc.), only one can be booked. The rest will be placed in the "Mass Intention" book.

Take comfort knowing that every Mass you request will be offered by a priest, even if it is not in your home parish.

SAINT WHO?

Born in 484 in Ciarraighe Luachra, near the present day town of Tralee, County Kerry, Ireland, Brendan was educated from the ages of one to five at Kileady, Limerick, under Saint Ita, the "foster mother of the Irish saints." He received his monastic training under Saint Erc in Kerry, where he lived in a beehive shaped cell and spent

hours each day meditating on the Scriptures. After further education at Cluainfois, Brendan was ordained and began to evangelize western Ireland; he is credited with founding a great many monasteries, including Annadown, Inishadroum, Ardfert and the great foundation at Clonfert, as well as others in Brittany and Scotland.

The medieval legand *Navigatio Sancti Brendani Abbatis* details the seven year sea voyage that Brendan undertook after receiving a vision of the "Promised Land" of the saints. Although many scholars question the truth of the *Navigatio,* in 1976 contemporary explorer Tim Severin made a case for its authenticity by reproducing Brendan's journey from Ireland to Newfoundland in a 36 foot hide covered boat.

Brendan is the patron saint of whales and seafarers. An old sailors' prayer asks that Brendan "help us remember that we have only one true port—heaven."

Eternal Father, through the intercession of Saint Brendan the Navigator, lead me forward by your gentle light.


