Benedict of Nursia ~2 March AD 480 – 21 March AD 547), often known as **Saint Benedict**, was an Italian Christian monk, writer, and theologian. He was venerated in the Catholic Church In 1964. Pope Paul VI declared Benedict a patron saint of Europe.

Benedict founded twelve communities for monks in present-day Lazio, Italy (about 40 miles to the east of Rome), before moving further south-east to Monte Cassino in the mountains of central Italy. The present-day Order of Saint Benedict emerged later and, moreover, is not an "order" as the term is commonly understood, but a confederation of autonomous congregations.

Benedict's main achievement, his *Rule of Saint Benedict*, contains a set of rules for his monks to follow. Heavily influenced by the writings of John Cassian (c. 360 – c. 435), it shows strong affinity with the earlier *Rule of the Master*, but it also has a unique spirit of balance, moderation and reasonableness which persuaded most Christian religious communities founded throughout the Middle Ages to adopt it. As a result, Benedict's Rule became one of the most influential religious rules in Western Christendom.

Saint Ildephonsus of Toledo

Feast Day: January 23


Saint Ildephonsus (also known as Ildefonse or Ildefonso) lived during the 7th century at a time when the Visigoths ruled a large portion of Spain. Son of a noble family, he was devoted to the religious life, not only choosing to be a monk, but also financing the establishment of a convent of nuns. He was the nephew of Saint Eugenius of Toledo and eventually succeeded him as the archbishop of Toledo.

It was a time when Toledo held considerable sway as the religious and political capital of Spain. As Archbishop, Ildephonsus contributed

greatly to Spain's spiritual growth. He nurtured the country's Marian devotion, especially with his document in defense of our Lady's perpetual virginity, a landmark of Spanish Marian theology.

Saint WHO ??

It is said that on December 18, 665, our Lady appeared to Ildephonsus and presented him with a chasuble in gratitude for his faithful service. This day was eventually



established as a feast— Our Lady of the Expectation. Ildephonsus later became the patron saint of Toledo.
