



Saint Colette of Corbie

Feast Day: March 6

Saint WHO ??

The daughter of a carpenter from Corbie in Picardy, France, Colette tried religious life three times before she entered the Franciscan Third Order and settled on her true vocation as an anchoress. She lived in a room or "anchorhold" attached tot the church in Corbie. A window that looked out on the altar permitted her to center her life on the Eucharist. In time, a steady flow visitors came to beg Colette's wise counsel.

Coltette received a vision of Saint Francis of Assisi asking Christ to send Colette to reform his Poor Clare nuns. At first, she was afraid that it came from the devil, yet she could not shake the sense that she was being called. She prayed for help and the priest Henri de Baume showed up at her anchorhold. Together they sought the aid of Peter de Luna, whom the French acknowledged as pope under the name of Benedict XIII (at the time, the papacy was contested). Peter

approved Colette's inspiration and made her superior of any convents she would establish or reform. Eventually she founded seventeen new convents in all. Colette's work was supported by her frequent prayer, which focused on the Passion of Christ. A vision near the end of her life presaged the devastation of the Reformation, but Colette was reassured that her reform of the Poor Clares would endure. Indeed, the Poor Clare Colettines remain today, faithful to Colette's original reforms.

People fast from all meat products for Fasika, the 55 days leading up to Easter Sunday in Ethiopia. They break their fast at Easter Supper, a feast even more popular than Christmas dinner there!



In the city of San Biagio Platani, people build Archi di Pasqua or Easter Arches. These are large, building-like structures people can walk under made entirely of bread and other foods.

EASTER Traditions Around the World

Third Sunday of Lent

Paul reminded the Corinthians, "We proclaim Christ crucified." Christ's weakness is stronger than any human strength. The power of the cross is greater than anything the world or evil has to combat it.

The Lenten season is one of repentance, self-denial, almsgiving, and prayer. Many in our modern world do not see any wisdom in denying themselves anything. Those swept away in a consumer culture want more and they want it faster, bigger, and better. They also are looking for easy and quick satisfaction, unwilling to wait long.

Paul speaks of the "foolishness of God" and how it is wiser than any human wisdom. Lent is a time to put aside that which we feel and think as humans and put on the attitude of Christ. The cross of Christ is neither easy nor fleeting, and it will ask us to deny our very selves for him. To the human mind it makes no sense. However, by putting on Christ and seeing with his eyes, we see reality with clarity. Our sacrifice can lead to riches that only a "foolish" man would covet. But it is exactly there that we are satisfied and fulfilled.






MASS Intentions


