



Saint Eulogius of Córdoba

Feast Day: March 11

By the year 711, Muslims had almost complete control of Spain. Córdoba was the capital and Moorish culture flourished there. Along with societal advances—opportunities for trade, public education and beautiful architecture—there was at first a form of religious tolerance. Nonetheless, the Islamic influence steadily undermined Christianity in Spain. Clerics in particular were targeted.

Among these was the holy priest Eulogius, who was adamant in defending the Catholic heritage in Spain against the new regime. "Can it really be said that we coexist peacefully when they destroy our basilicas, insult priests and oblige us to pay an intolerable tax every month?" A friend of monastic communities

and head of a school, he became, as his friend and biographer Pablo Alvaro wrote, "the instigator of martyrs and their eulogist."

Eulogius was an inspiring preacher and a faithful companion who encouraged his hearers by word and example to give testimony to their faith. Many Christians, especially from religious communities, were moved to publicly affirm their faith in Christ and denounce Islam, despite the death sentence this could incur. Eulogius himself was killed for helping a noblewoman who had converted from Islam, declaring it was his duty to help others learn about the faith. Offered an opportunity to escape death, he responded, "If you only knew what awaits us!"






