

Saint WHO ??

SAINT Clotilda
Feast Day: 3

"Adorned with the assemblage of all virtues," Clotilda was born around the year 470, in the kingdom of Burgundy (south-eastern France). The Germanic tribes who controlled these regions were mostly Arian, but Clotilda was raised a devout Catholic and her sister became a nun. Clotilda herself was married at about nineteen to Clovis, king of the Franks, a violent pagan tribe.


Marriage to a pagan king was surely not an easy prospect for the pious Clotilda, yet she accepted it as her duty. It is said she was so abundantly charming, and Clovis so eager to marry her, that he granted her every wish for the free exercise of her faith. They were married by Saint Remigius, who became Clotilda's friend and spiritual adviser.



Saint Paul's words in 1 Corinthians 7:14, *the unbelieving husband is made holy through his wife*, proved true in the case of Clotilda. A loving and supportive wife, she won the heart of her pagan husband. Their children were baptized Catholic. And Clovis himself was baptized on Christmas Day in 496, a turning point in France's history. Together, Clovis and Clotilda did much to establish Catholicism in France and they are buried together in the Church of Saint Genevieve in Paris.



St. Norbert of Xanten (c. 1075-1134) after a violent conversion experience, was ordained and became an itinerant preacher who founded the Norbertine order. He preached against heresies denying the Blessed Sacrament, which earned him the title "Apostle of the Blessed Sacrament."
