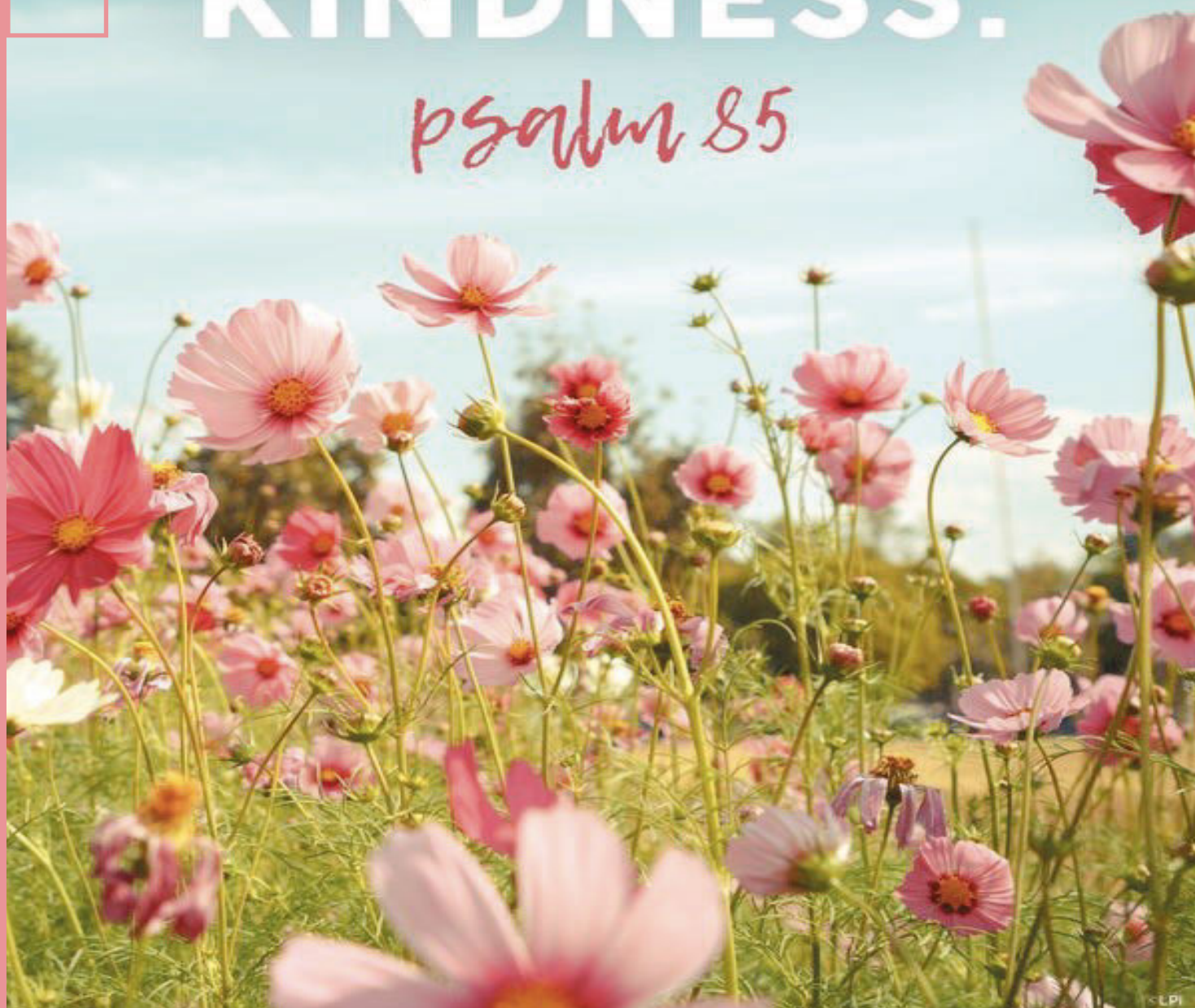

Try to see and briefly say hello to the client each time you deliver.

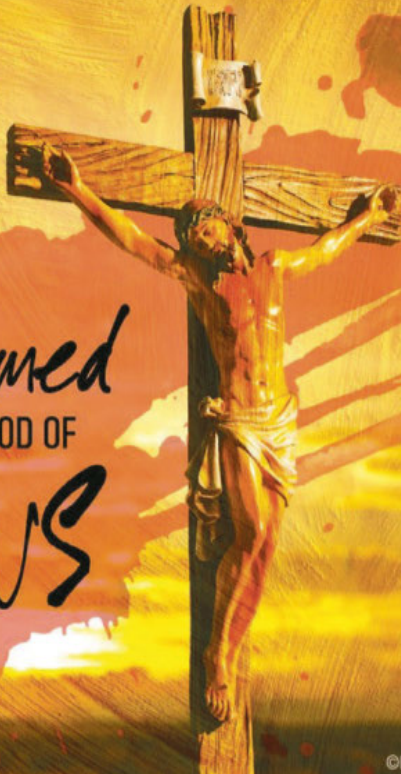
Call the Meals on Wheels office if a client is not home.

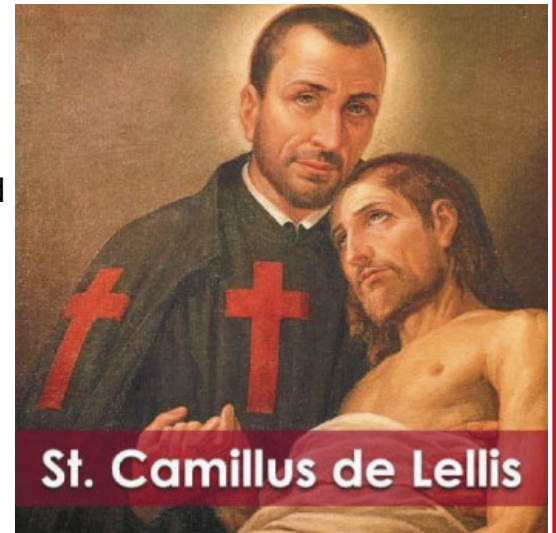
Saint WHO ??

SAINT Camillus de Lellis
Feast Day: July 18

A native of the Abruzzi region of Italy, at seventeen Camillus joined the army to fight the Turks. He was addicted to gambling and eventually lost even the proverbial shirt off his back. When he hit rock bottom, he made his way to the Capuchins, taking a job at their friary in Manfredonia. A kindly friar converted him to penance, but the order would not receive him because of a wound on his leg.

Hoping to be cured, Camillus went to San Giacomo Hospital in Rome. When he got there, he was struck at the deeply demoralized culture of the hospital. The nurses were unkempt and inattentive and led disordered lives. Despite being a patient himself, Camillus began to care for others. He was raised to a level of administrator and at the same time came under the spiritual care of Saint Philip Neri. In 1584, Camillus was ordained and founded the Order of the Clerks Regular, Ministers of the Infirm, or the Camillians, to serve as priest-nurses. To poverty, chastity and obedience he added a fourth vow of "perpetual physical and spiritual assistance to the sick, especially those with the plague."

Camillus urged his nurses to offer attentive care with up-to-date skill. A contemporary noted, "In the sick he saw the person of Christ. His reverence in their presence was as great as if he were really and truly in the presence of his Lord."

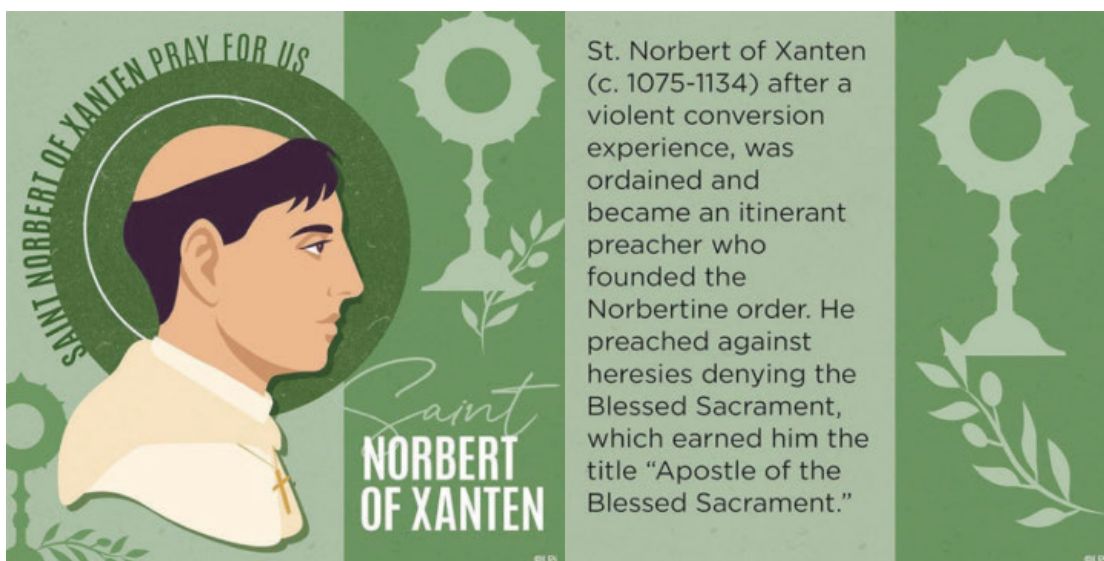
Eight new choir robes are currently needed due to the addition of several new members and to the deterioration of some older ones.
