

HOW TO PRAY THE ROSARY

- 1. Looking at the cross, we hold it while we make the sign of the cross and pray the Apostles' Creed which is a summary of all the things we believe as Catholics.
- 2. On this separate bead, we pray an Our Father, the prayer that Jesus taught us.
- 3. On each of the next three beads, we pray the Hail Mary.
- 4. On this separate bead, we announce the first mystery. (e.g., Joyful) We reflect on what happened to Jesus at this time and we think about what it means in our lives today. We pray the Our Father.
- 5. We pray one Hail Mary on each of the next 10 beads. Then we pray the Glory Be.
- 6. On this separate bead, we announce the second mystery, reflect, and pray the Our Father.
- 7. We pray one Hail Mary on each of the next ten beads. Then we pray the Glory Be.
- 8. On this separate bead, we announce the third mystery, reflect, and pray the Our Father.
- 9. We pray one Hail Mary on each of the next ten beads. Then we pray the Glory Be.
- 10. On this separate bead, we announce the fourth mystery, reflect, and pray the Our Father.
- 11. We pray one Hail Mary on each of the next ten beads. Then we pray the Glory Be.
- 12. On this separate bead, we announce the fifth mystery, reflect, and pray the Our Father.
- 13. We pray one Hail Mary on each of the next ten beads. Then we pray the Glory Be.
- 14. We have now reached the end of the Rosary. On the medal that connects the beads we pray the Hail Holy Queen.



Apostles Creed

Saint WHO ??

SAINT Martha Feast Day: July 29



Martha is featured in two moments in the Scriptures. In that short space, a picture emerges of a woman who moves from anxiety to deep and abiding faith. When we first meet her (Lk 10:38-42), she is serving at dinner, while her sister Mary sits and listens at the Master's feet. Martha pleads with Jesus to direct her sister to help her. But Jesus instead chides Martha. She is worried about many things, he tells her, but *Mary has chosen the better part and it will not be taken from her.*

When next we meet Martha (Jn 11:1-44), Christ has arrived at Bethany, where her brother Lazarus has just died. Again, Mary sits as her sister rushes out to see the Lord. Lord, if you had been here, my brother would not have died, she anxiously tells him. But after the Lord corrects her, she professes with fervor and great faith: Now I know that whatever you ask God, God will give you.

This deep confidence in Christ provokes his revelation: I am the resurrection and the life; whoever believes in me, even if he dies, will live, and everyone who lives and believes in me will never die. He then asks her, Do you believe this? And Martha's response is confident and firm: Yes, Lord, I have come to believe that you are the Messiah, the Son of God, the one who is coming in to the world. Martha is the patroness of housewives, domestic servants and cooks.
