



SAINT Gobnait February 11

Gobnait (also Gobnata or Abigail) lived in Ireland in the 6th century. While her story comes to us mostly through legend, devotion to her is ancient and well established. Driven from home by a family feud, shed fled to an island, where she stayed until an angel appeared telling her: "This is not the place of your resurrection." Following the angel's instructions, Gobnait set off on a long pilgrimage of sorts,


marked by churches and wells which now bear her name. The journey ended in Ballyvourney, where Gobnait settled down and established a convent. She became a beloved figure, renowned for healing and protection.

renowned for healing and protection.

Her name (said to be the equivalent of the Hebrew "Deborah") means "Honey Bee," and she had a special affinity with bees. It is thought that she used their honey in her healing remedies. It is said that they also assisted her by attacking thieves who stole the nuns' cattle, forcing them to return the stolen livestock. In Celtic culture, bees were also associated with the departure of the soul from the body. Perhaps Gobnait kept

them as a reminder of the resurrection she sought after.

After her death, Ballyvourney became a popular pilgrimage destination and remains so to this day. Many invoke her for healing, and the large number of crutches left in the churchyard testify to her loving intercession.


