

The student population of Roberts K-8 School is 615 and the school serves PK-8. At Roberts K-8 School, 5% of students scored at or above the proficient level for math, and 13% scored at or above that level for reading. The school's minority student enrollment is 81%.

SAINT HUGH of Grenoble Feast Day: April 1

The son of noble and devout parents, Hugh received a fine education, became a canon at the cathedral of Valance, France and was named Bishop of Grenoble at the young age of twenty-eight. Still a layman at the time, Hugh was ordained and sent to Rome to be consecrated. While there, he shared with Pope Gregory VII how he suffered from frequent temptations to blasphemy. The pope assured him that these were for his purification and encouraged him to go forward in his work. Hugh continued to suffer the temptations until his dying

day, throughout a long life of humble service.

In Grenoble, Hugh faced great challenges in reforming the clergy and defending the Church against the encroachment of the emperor. A man of humanity and prudence, he was tender tot the brokenhearted, yet stern

with the unrepentant.

Hugh felt the great weight of his office and repeatedly tried to leave or resign. Once he managed to get into a

Benedictine monastery for a year before the pope ordered him back.

Hugh gave Saint Bruno the mountain property for the Grande Chartreuse, the motherhouse of the Carthusian order and he retired to a cell there at the end of his life. After having served fifty-two years as bishop, he suffered a dramatic loss of memory, yet he could still recite the Our Father and the Psalms, which he did faithfully until the day of his death.




