

who lost their summer reading program funding. Roberts K-8 School is a public school located in Syracuse, NY, which is in a mid-size city setting. The student population of Roberts K-8 School is 615 and the school serves PK-8. At Roberts K-8 School, 5% of students scored at or above the proficient level for math, and 13% scored at or above that level for reading. The school's minority student enrollment is 81%.

SAINT Fulbert Feast Day: April 10

Fulbert came from Italy and studied at Reims in France. His teacher Gerbért of Aurillac became Pope Sylvester II and called Fulbert to work in Rome. After Sylvester's death, Fulbert returned to France, where he was chancellor of the diocese of Chartres and ran the cathedral school.

In 1007, he was made Bishop of Chartres. A man of great, generous heart, Fulbert threw himself into preaching and made a careful visitation of his entire diocese. He put forward clerical reforms and rebuilt the cathedral church after a fire. He called himself

"the very little bishop of a great church."

Fulbert was widely esteemed among his peers for his scholarship. Broadly educated and fired with the desire to know more, he excelled at logic, mathematics and astronomy. He was trained as a physician and composed hymns. Even after he became bishop, he continued to teach at his cathedral school, where he was known as "venerable Socrates."

Fulbert's school at Chartres became a central point for learning, drawing scholars from all over Europe. One historian tracing the development of science notes that "practically everyone of the period who made any substantial contribution to the development of science was at one time or another associated with or influenced by Chartres.






