





SAINT Benedict Joseph Labre Feast Day: April 16

Born in France in 1748, Benedict was the eldest of fifteen children. He loved to study the scripture and the lives of the saints, and eagerly pursued a priestly religious vocation. Despite repeated efforts, however, he was turned away by the Trappists, the Carthusians and the Cistercians.

Accepting his rejections, Benedicts took up the life of a pilgrim. He journeyed in poverty, relying on the kindness of others for his survival. He did not beg, but only accepted gifts that were freely offered. Even these he sometimes gave away to those he deemed more needy than himself. As he traveled, he grew terribly ragged and dirty. His own confessor said he had never seen a more miserable beggar.

After four years on the road, Benedict settled in Rome, which for him meant living in a hole in the Colosseum. Known as :the poor man of the Forty Hours Devotion," he spent most of his time praying before the Eucharist. At the age of thirtyfive, he collapsed during Holy Week, and was taken to a nearby house where he died shortly

thereafter. Suddenly the city of Rome erupted with cries that "the saint" was dead. Police and soldiers were called to keep order at his funeral, so great were the crowds. He was canonized in 1883.




