# SAINT NICETAS of REMESIANA Feast Day: June 22

On June 22, the Roman Martyrology, the Church's liturgical catalogue of saints, remembers Saint Nicetas, who "by his preaching made nations mild and gentle that before were barbarous and savage." Nicetas served as a missionary bishop of Remesiana, present-day Bela Palanka, Serbia.

Nicetas shares his June 22 feast with Saint Paulinus of Nola, who was his friend and an accomplished poet.

Paulinus wrote with boundless admiration for Nicetas, who had tamed the hearts of the fierce Bessi tribesmen in a brutal land of snow and ice, bringing them "like sheep into Christ's fold."

Nicetas' written works include a letter exhorting the observance of vigils on Friday and Saturday nights and a pre-baptism catechesis in six booklets, treating of the Creed, faith and the Trinity, among other topics. Some now believe Nicetas was the author of the ancient Latin hymn *Te Deum*, long attributed to Saint Ambrose. A song of praise and thanksgiving to God in his Triune majesty, the *Te Deum* is recited in the Liturgy of the Hours on Sundays outside of Lent, during the entirety of the octaves of Christmas and Easter, and on feasts and solemnities. It is also traditionally intoned on the occasion of the election of kings.

# **GOSPEL MEDITATION - ENCOURAGE DEEPER UNDERSTANDING OF SCRIPTURE**

# June 22, 2025 The Most Holy Body and Blood of Christ Luke 9:11-17

A Catholic friend of mine occasionally says, "The Eucharist is not a noun. It's a verb." In so saying, he is making the point that the Eucharist isn't simply Jesus' bodily presence given to us in holy Communion. It also manifests the dynamic pattern by which Christ actively loves and saves us. He teaches us to cooperate with that pattern. This Eucharist actually embodies four verbs: Jesus takes, blesses, breaks, and gives. Let's consider each one.

He takes: Do we acknowledge that we are totally in God's hands? Do we receive everything in our lives as a gift, and act responsibly with it?

He blesses: Do we actively reflect that Jesus makes us holy in our baptism? Do we embrace our bodies and souls as temples of God, worthy of love, peace, and joy?

He breaks: Do we run from failure and disappointment, from getting old or being ignored? Are we too worried about getting hurt or sick? Do we embrace our sufferings with confidence?

He gives: Are we willing to make our lives a gift for others? Are we confident that we will always have enough love to give to others, that God will always provide enough for us? Do we rejoice in giving away what we have to others, expecting nothing in return? This is the dynamic life the Eucharist empowers us to live.







