SAINT BONAVENTURE Feast Day: July 15

Do you ever get stuck with the tough jobs? It's well known that the Franciscan Order was incredibly influential throughout history. But one of the most challenging times for a new movement is surviving the death of the founder. Bonaventure joined the



Franciscan Order almost two decades after the passing of St. Francis. Initially, the young man's theological insights earned him a prime faculty position at the University of Paris. More than his academic skill, however, he was known for his deep devotion to Christ. He was elected the General Minister of the Franciscan Order, right in the thick of controversies. Some friars had conflicting views of how to interpret St. Francis' poverty as the order grew. Others started a new heresy, saying that the Franciscan Order began a new era of the Holy Spirit, replacing the era of Jesus and the authority of the Church. St. Bonaventure weathered these crises with grace, restructuring the order when necessary and offering a more organized perspective on the insights of St. Francis.

URGE NY GOVERNOR HOCHUL TO SAY NO TO "PHYSICIAN ASSISTED SUICIDE"

The State Assembly and Senate have approved the so called "Medical Aid In Dying Act"

It allows any person 18 and above, who is terminally ill, to request the help of a doctor in committing suicide. The Doctor provides the means for them to kill themselves; observes the suicide and confirms the person is dead. Canada passed a similar bill in 2016 which, in 2027, will expand the list to those who suffer from depression, anxiety and anorexia. That Bill has now been approved by and Assembly. the Senate We should offer the suffering comfort, care and love...not suicide.

OUR LADY OF MOUNT CARMEL

The origins of this feast reach all the way back to the Old Testament. In the book of Kings, we read the story of the prophet Elijah. Much of his prayer, fasting, and public ministry occurred from Carmel, a mountain in Israel. Christian hermits -- seeking solitude -- made their homes on the mountain during the first millennium. Over time, the hermits assembled into a community and were given a Rule of Life. They named their church after Mary -- Our Lady of Mount Carmel. Political upheaval forced the Carmelite order out of the Holy Land and into Europe, where they established monasteries for both men and women across the continent. Many great saints and doctors of the Church have come from the Carmelite order, including St. Teresa of Avila, St. John of the Cross, St. Therese of Lisieux, and St. Edith Stein.
