# Saint Monica Feast Day: August 27

Raising faithful children is no easy task. For St. Monica, it seemed nearly impossible. Her husband wasn't Christian and often mocked her faith. Their son, Augustine, fell quickly into wild ways. He and his friends drank, stole, and caroused throughout town. Monica never stopped praying for Augustine, no matter how far he strayed. Augustine became swept up in heresy, a false form of Christianity. He lived with a mistress and had a child out of wedlock. All the while, Monica kept praying. Conversion came slowly to Augustine, but at age 32, he was finally baptized. Augustine would go on to



become a priest, then bishop, then worldrenowned theologian whose works have stood the test of time. May St. Monica and St. Augustine inspire us to never stop praying for our loved ones.

# OUR STAINED GLASS WINDOWS ~ Saint Ignatius Gift of John G. Roder Location: North side of Saint Matthew's Church

Saint Ignatius of Loyola, was a Basque Spaniard Catholic priest and theologian, who, with six companions, founded the religious order of the Society of Jesus (Jesuits), and became its first Superior General, in Paris in 1541.

Ignatius envisioned the purpose of the Society of Jesus to be missionary work and teaching. In addition to the vows of chastity, obedience and poverty of other religious orders of the church, Loyola instituted a fourth vow for Jesuits of obedience to the Pope, to engage in projects ordained by the pontiff. Jesuits were instrumental in leading the Counter-Reformation.

As a former soldier, Ignatius paid particular attention to the spiritual formation of his recruits and recorded his method in the *Spiritual Exercises (1548)*. In time the method has become known as Ignatian spirituality. He was beatified in 1609 and was canonized as a saint on 12 March 1622. His feast day is celebrated on 31 July. He is patron saint of the Basque provinces of Gipuzkoa and Biscay as well as of the Society of Jesus. He was declared the patron saint of all spiritual retreats by Pope Pius XI in 1922.

Altar Safety at St Matthew's

The altar steps at St Matthew's are steep and the floor is marble. To ensure the safety and ease of access for everyone Fr Wirkes has asked me to contact Raulli & Sons, a professional contact of John Backenstross, to create and install four more handrails in the sanctuary. They will match the ones near the pulpit and priest's chair. Two will be placed on the steps leading to the Tabernacle, and two will be placed at the communion rail on the final step from the sanctuary to the floor. The total cost is \$ 7,420.

Saint Matthew's Parking Lot

The parking lot at Saint Matthew's Church has recently seen some needed repairs. Two depressions were fixed, one near the handicap parking at the side entrance and the other directly in front of the office which caused a massive pooling problem during rain and snow melt. The depressions were saw-cut and filled. Then the entire parking lot was resealed and the parking lines were repainted. The resealing was handled by Superior Seal and Paving at a cost of \$11,561.


