He is sometimes called Saint Guido or the Poor Man of Anderlecht, and the Catholics of

Anderlecht, Belgium, later built a church to honor him (together with Saint Peter). Saint Guy's fame would have surprised his contemporaries, who only knew him as the man who swept the floor of the church.

Guy was born into a poor but pious family. He recognized that it was just as spiritually dangerous for a poor man to be jealous of the wealthy as it was for a rich man to take from the poor. He worked as a day laborer and shared his wages with those in need. He was delighted when he was offered the job of sacristan in the church in Anderlecht.

Guy arranged flowers on the altar, arranged the altar for Mass, rang the bell for Mass and Vespers, cared for the altar linens and vestments and even kept the floor clean. But he was persuaded by a businessman to invest the little money he had in a trading venture. Rather than receiving the profit which he planned to spend on the needy, he found himself penniless and unemployed. In penance, Guy traveled to holy places as a pilgrim for several years and died soon after returning to Anderlecht, where the poor, hardworking man has been honored ever since.





Saint Matthew's Parking Lot




