FUEL ASSISTANCE/SNAP

If you have not filed for Fuel Assistance yet, you still have time! Fuel Assistance season runs until April 30, 2022. You may have noticed that your fuel and utilities may have increased recently. Fuel assistance is a great way to take a bite out of the cost of staying warm.

Have you been to the grocery store lately? Have you noticed the cost of food? You may qualify for the Supplemental Nutrition Assistance Program (SNAP). Many folks don't realize how simple it is to sign up for SNAP. If you would like help with Fuel Assistance and SNAP, please call Lori at 726-2846.

Tax Information

Soon you will start receiving tax documents from 2021. In the past we have been able to assist with helping you file your taxes.

At this time, we are not

able to help with appointments at the Senior Center. Last year we had referred folks to Springfield Partners for Community Action.

After confirming with them, they will once again be taking appointments for low income seniors. Please call 413-263-6500 to schedule an appointment.

Please keep in mind that tax season is the best time for scammers to try and talk you into giving them financial information. One of the more recent ones to surface is the "agent" on the phone will tell you how easy it is to file by phone because of Covid 19. They will tell you if you give them your information by phone, they can fill all the forms for you electronically. NO!! This is not true! The government is not going to ask you for your private information on the phone. If you receive a call like this, hang up. You can call 1-800-829-1040 for legitimate information and to report any scam calls.

The Agawam Senior Center is HAPPY to present Laugh for the Fun of it with Chief Happiness Officer, Trevor Smith.

Agawam, Ma. – Laugh the stress of life away at the Agawam Council on Aging on March 22nd at 1:00pm 2022, when Trevor Smith of Blue Sky Consulting will present a program called "Laugh for the Fun of it: Creating Healthy Lifestyles through Laughter."

Participants will learn a systematic method of chuckles, chortles, giggling and guffawing that promises to help reduce stress, prevent hardening of the attitudes and contribute to world peace. The laughter routine, designed to make anyone feel better, works without using jokes or comedy to stimulate the laughter.

Smith has completed training offered by the World Laughter Tour, Inc. and Laughter Yoga International to become a Certified Laughter Leader and has organized and facilitated Therapeutic Laughter programs for a variety of community organizations.

"There can be many sensitive issues around humor, such as people not getting jokes or being offended by them," Smith said. "So we skip jokes

altogether. We laugh with each other, never at each other. Peals of genuine happiness-and-health-boosting laughter ring out and roll on."

Smith leads Laughter Clubs across the Valley in workplaces, schools, health clubs, senior centers, libraries and nursing homes. A physician in India originated the laughter club idea in 1995, and three years later, it was

taken up by an American psychologist, Steve Wilson of Columbus, Ohio, who borrowed some ideas from yoga and founded the World Laughter Tour, Inc. Smith said laughter is proven to be a healing and a factor in happiness and good health.


