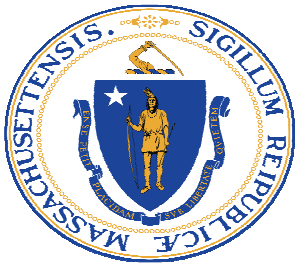
## EMERGENCY PREPAREDNESS PROGRAM

The purpose of the program is to explore how to ensure that seniors with disabilities have the assistance they need in times of emergency. Residents will learn about state resources, local efforts and how to self-prepare.

- An ice storm leaves the region without electricity.
- Fire in an industrial plant forces evacuation of surrounding communities.
- A train jumps the tracks, releasing a cloud of toxic chemicals.

Communities across the Commonwealth are planning for emergency situations like these, some are natural and others are man-made; some require evacuation while others require sheltering at home.

Participants will learn about the emergency response resources and procedures within their local communities and the steps that can be taken personally to prepare for emergency situations. **Seniors with disabilities will also receive an “Emergency Go Pack” with essential items that might be needed during an emergency.
