



#### Are you registered to Vote? Need a mail in voter registration card or absentee ballot?

There are three more elections scheduled for 2022, Sept. 6th State Primary, October 3rd Special Town Election to fill the vacant Select Board seat and Nov. 8th State Election. If someone is new to town, has never registered to vote or would like to change their address or political party, they can use the mail-in voter registration card. Qualifications for an absentee ballot include difficulty getting to the polls—whether due mobility issues, being out of town on the day of the election, or having difficulty with the parking at the High School.

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#### Need Help Buying Groceries? SNAP can help!

SNAP can help you buy healthy food. The new income limits are now available. SNAP is administered by the Department of Transitional Assistance (DTA).

#### SNAP benefits include:

- Monthly funds on an EBT card to buy food as determined by DTA
- \$40, \$60, or \$80 per month put back on your EBT card when you use SNAP to buy local produce via the Healthy Incentives Program (HIP). Qualifying amount is determined by household size. (1-2 people = \$40) https://www.mass.gov/service-details/Massachusetts-healthy-incentives-program-hip
