

The **Healthy Incentive Program**, also known as **HIP**, is an incentive program in Massachusetts. Families and individuals on **SNAP** are eligible to buy fruits and vegetables from participating vendors. You can now apply for SNAP benefits by appointment at the Gardner Senior Center.


