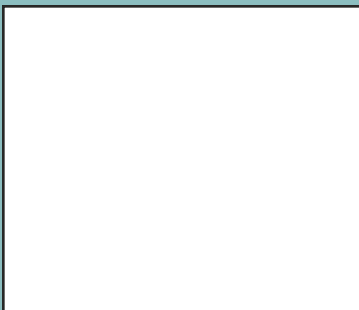

The United States Census Bureau is looking for temporary workers for the 2020 census, they will be hiring hundreds of people from the vicinity. These are good paying jobs starting at \$14.50/hr for office clerks, \$18.50/hr for office supervisors, \$18/hr for field staff and \$20/hr for field supervisors.

Many of the jobs are Work from Home positions—people work right in their neighborhood requiring little if any travel. They set their own hours from 20 per week up to 40 per week. Jobs are temporary—from 6 weeks to 18 months. This spring and summer, we will be employing our first large wave of operation—all the work happens during daylight hours: the work is to verify addresses so human interaction and interviewing are minimized.

Other jobs are clerical in nature and will work out of the Area Census Office (ACO), once it opens. These jobs will be 35 hours per week with standard office hours. They will be longer in duration, many lasting until June 2020.

All applications are done online at www.2020census.gov/jobs, it takes about 45-60 minutes. If you have a problem navigating the system call 1-855-job-2020.

NEWS FROM SHINE MAY 2019

Need Help with the Cost of your Prescription Medication?? Prescription Advantage can Help!!

Prescription Advantage is a state-run program which helps many seniors pay for their prescription drugs. Eligibility is based on *income only* and there is *no asset limit!*

Who can join?

If you are a **Massachusetts resident, eligible for Medicare,** and are:

65 years or older with an annual income at or less than \$62,450 for a single person or \$84,550 for a married couple.

OR

Under 65 years and disabled, with an annual income at or less than \$23,481 for a single person or \$31,791 for a married couple.

You may also join...if you are 65 years or older and **not eligible for Medicare. There is no income limit.**

There is **no charge** for joining Prescription Advantage, if you have an annual income at or less than \$37,470 for a single person and \$50,730 for a married couple. There is a \$200 per person annual enrollment fee for those with higher incomes.

Call Prescription Advantage today to enroll on the phone or ask for an application form. You can reach Prescription Advantage at 1-800-AGE-INFO (1-800-243-4636), then press or say **2**.

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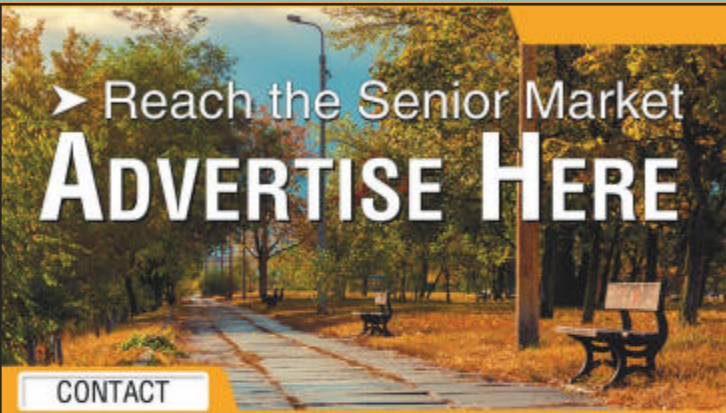
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HOME SECURITY TEAM

VAN RIDE

The MART VAN operates rides, for Leominster residents, from 6am to 5pm, Monday through Friday. Vans travel in Leominster .50¢, and in Fitchburg, Lancaster and Lunenburg .75¢.

BELOW ARE SOME OF THE RULES FOR MART VAN RIDES:

- All van rides are by reservations only.
- To book any ride, **YOU MUST CALL THE SENIOR CENTER ON THE PREVIOUS DAY, BEFORE 1:30PM** at (978) 534-7511. Rides may be scheduled up to a week in advance.
- All rides must be scheduled a “MINIMUM” of **45 minutes before** the time of your appointment. You will be picked up at the same place the van dropped you off, unless otherwise specified. There is a minimum of **1 hour and 15** within Leominster and **1 hour and 30** minutes if going outside of Leominster from pick up to pick up.
- Shopping carts must be folded and put behind the seat on the floor and out of the aisle. You are limited to the amount of bags you can carry on the vehicle and will fit in the seat with you.
- Remember, the **VAN can run LATE!** We are not responsible if you miss an appointment.

If the van is running late, **after hours**, call the Fitchburg Mart at (978) 345-7711 ext. 2255.

OUT OF TOWN

There is also a shuttle service daily to Worcester or Boston, for medical-related reasons. All out of town rides leave from the Senior Center parking lot at 100 West St. All rides are first come, first serve. Fare for Worcester is \$8.00 each way and Boston \$10.00 each way.

THERE IS NO CHARGE TO JOIN THE LEOMINSTER SENIOR CENTER
