The Fall Auction was on Saturday November 20th. It was lots of fun for those who attended. Thank you to all the volunteers who made it possible.










Winter Holiday Extravaganza

4 eggs
1 cup flaked or shredded coconut
3/4 cup sugar
1/2 cup Bisquick baking mix

Heat oven to 350 degrees. Grease pie plate. Place all ingredients in blender container. Cover and blend on high 15 seconds. Pour into plate. Bake until knife inserted in center comes out clean. 50 to 55 minutes: cool.



The Emergency Broadband Benefit Program

The Emergency Broadband Benefit (EBB), a program created by Congress in response to the COVID-19 pandemic. EBB will provide a discount of up to \$50 per month towards broadband service for eligible households.

You must confirm eligibility through the <u>National Verifier</u>. To qualify, a member of your household must meet at least one of the following criteria:

- Qualifies for the federal Lifeline program, including:
- Medicaid
- SNAP



- Supplemental Security Income (SSI)
- Federal Public Housing Assistance
- Veterans and Survivors Pension Benefit
- Receives benefits under the free and reduced-price school lunch program or the school breakfast program, including through the USDA Community Eligibility Provision, or did so in the 2019-2020 school year
- Experienced a substantial loss of income since February 29, 2020, and the household had a total income in 2020 below \$99,000 for single filers and \$198,000 for joint filers.

Congress recently created the **Affordable**Connectivity Program, a new long-term, \$14
billion program, which will replace the
Emergency Broadband Benefit Program. ...


Households enrolled in the Emergency Broadband Benefit Program as of 12/31/21 will continue to receive their current monthly benefit until 3/1/22 at which time you will have to enroll in the Affordable **Connectivity Program**

On our tree lined street, a huge hornets nest hung high in the maple tree in front of our house. It was the end of October, and the nest was vacant. The hornets life span is short lived.


