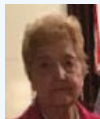


Second Booster Shot







The Stangz Car Show

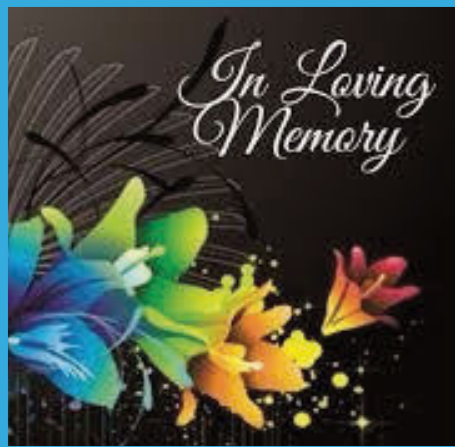
