



Emergency Exits & Fire Pull Locations:

- Front Entrance: the usual entrance / exit
- Back Hallway Door: end of hallway, to the right of the Exercise Room
- Dining Room: double doors at the back of the room (rear of building)
- **Kitchen:** back door (rear of building)



Every exit has a **Fire Pull** to the right of the door (except for the Kitchen back door exit – it's to the left). This will sound the fire alarm throughout the building.

Fire Extinguisher Locations:

- Back Door: end of hallway, to the right of the Exercise Room
- **Dining Room:** by the water fountain
- Kitchen: in alcove, under phone

Located in the office area – under the cabinets by the copier.
