



DSS is excited to continue and expand our outreach efforts in the community. Starting March 2022 we are partnering with the Ruth Enlow Libraries in the Accident, Grantsville, Kitzmiller and Friendsville communities. These locations, along with the Garrett County Community Action Senior Centers in Kitzmiller and Grantsville, will allow DSS to provide regular monthly in-person assistance to anyone in need. A representative from DSS will be on-site to answer questions and provide assistance with applications and accessing services. We plan to continue to expand the locations and hours of this in person assistance in the future. Please see the schedule below for specific times and locations.

In addition to on site, in person support, these locations will also house DSS paperwork. A file box will be left at each location and will contain blank applications, change forms and other forms that customers may need to use to access services. Customers can stop by at any time and pick up the paperwork they need. Postage-paid envelopes are also available.

This free nationwide service, staffed by master's-level clinicians and specialists, provides confidential support and information to people living with the disease, caregivers, families and the public. Our translation service accommodates more than 200 languages. Dial 711 to connect with a TRS operator.

PROGRAMS AND SERVICES

The following chapter programs and services are available by phone and/or virtually:

Support groups: Facilitated by trained individuals, support groups provide an opportunity for caregivers, family members and others to dealing with the disease to share valuable information, caregiving tips and concerns throughout the Alzheimer's journey.

Care consultations: Provided by professionally trained staff, this free service offers personalized assistance to help families and caregivers better understand the disease, manage care, resolve conflicts, and plan for the future.

Education programs: Our free education programs are open to the public and cover topics such as warning signs and basics of the disease, caregiving, legal and financial planning, and healthy lifestyle choices for the brain and body. Presentations are available for companies and organizations.


We also offer conferences and trainings for caregivers and professionals throughout the year.

Early stage programs: These programs for individuals in the early stages of Alzheimer's and dementia and their care partners offer specialized information and support and social engagement opportunities to meet others in a relaxed and comfortable setting.

Garrett County Seniors, DSS is coming to you!

- Do you have questions about what services Garrett County Department of Social Services (DSS) can provide to you? Do you already receive SNAP or Medical Assistance services and have questions about your case? Do you need to make changes? Do you need to pick up an application or other paperwork? **We are HERE FOR YOU!**

Beginning January 2022, a representative from the Garrett County DSS will come to the Grantsville and Kitzmiller Senior Center sites 1 day a month to answer your questions, assist you with applications and changes, or to receive any completed paperwork.

Grantsville is scheduled for the 3rd Tuesday of the month from 10 AM - 2 PM. Kitzmiller is scheduled for the 3rd Thursday of the month from 10 AM - 2 PM. The plan is to return to these locations the third week of each month.

In addition to having representatives on-site at two locations, DSS paperwork will be available at ALL senior centers county wide. You may pick up the paperwork and return it to the drop box at either the Grantville DSS or Oakland DSS offices, or you may use the postage paid envelope provided to return it via mail.

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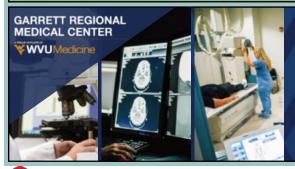
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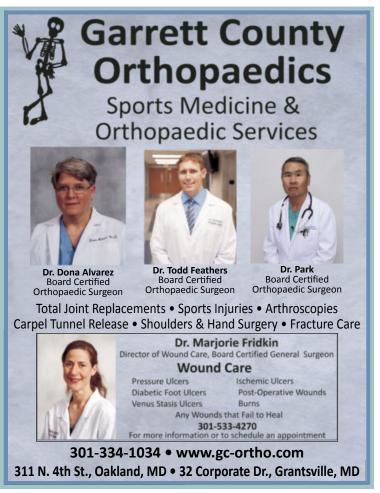
