THE CENTRAL BUCKS SENIOR ACTIVITY CENTER

The Central Bucks Senior Activity Center (CBSAC) is one of four, full-service senior centers operated by Bucks County Association for Retired and Senior Citizens, a not-for-profit corporation on Aging. This project is funded, in part, under a contract with the Pennsylvania Department of Aging and The County of Bucks. The BCARSC is an equal opportunity employer.

All programs and services provided at the four Senior Centers through the Area Agency on Aging are offered without regard to race, religion, political affiliation, income level, or personal background. The Central Bucks Senior Activity Center serves all senior citizens, aged 55 and over in the Central Bucks area including Doylestown Borough, Doylestown Township, New Britain Borough, New Britain Township, Chalfont Borough, Buckingham Township, Plumstead Township, Warrington Borough, and Warwick Borough, as well as neighboring communities. Geographic locations are not criteria for membership, and the Center draws members from as far as Perkasie, Warminster, Lansdale, New Hope and Solebury.

CBSAC is an activity Center, helping members to lead richer, fuller lives by providing a variety of programs to both entertain and stimulate. It has an elected executive board. There are monthly meetings at which members may express their support and concerns. This Center has been providing services to the Bucks area for over 30 years.

CO-PILOT NEWS

The CoPilot system is being re-evaluated. For safety reasons, members will temporarily no longer use the computer to check in. There will be a CBSAC volunteer to check members in as they enter the building through the front door. You may still swipe your CoPilot card if you have one.

You will be asked which activities you will be attending and if you would like to preregister for both lunch, Bingo and other activities.

We will have more than one CoPilot check in station at the front desk when needed so the process should go more smoothly.

In addition to checking in on CoPilot we will still maintain a check in list which is a safety requirement from the County. Before you leave the building please check out at the front desk to have your name crossed off the list.

Home PRE-registration: If you are comfortable with using a computer at home, you can now PreRegister from home for Bingo, Applegate distribution (when it's available), and even for lunch. Go to www.copilotcommunity.com, supply an email address, and have the number on the back of your CoPilot bar code card handy instead of a password. If you do not see the Central Bucks Senior Center at top, use the CHANGE CENTER box to get there. You can then use the menu at the top of the page to select PREREGISTRATION to do so for Bingo, Applegate and Lunch. Use the NEXT button top/right to move through the weeks available. It's pretty intuitive, so explore as necessary. You can't do any damage to your account, so, please, CHECK IT OUT.



FLAG RETIREMENT



As spring begins, Doylestown's Memorial Day planning Committee has already begun preparations for the annual Memorial Day Parade and Observance. This will be the 154th observance in Doylestown. It is the day when we honor the memory of those who gave all in their service to our country. Flags are lowered to half-staff until noon. This year's observance will occur on Monday, May 30, 2022. Prior to Memorial Day, local cemeteries remove flags (approximately

2500) from the markers at Veterans' gravesites. Doylestown's Albert R. Atkinson, Jr. American Legion Post 210 with support from other Veteran groups, Scouts, Civil Air Patrol and Young Marines will replace these flags May 19 -26. These flags will be "retired" by the Post on June 11, 2022. Flags may be brought to the Post, 315 North Street by community members and deposited in the receptacle at the rear of the building 24/7 and will also be retired at that time.

As a convenience for Central Bucks Senior Center and its members, the Post has placed a smaller receptacle in the lobby of the CBSC to deposit flags for retirement. If the flag is a smaller one with an attached stick, please remove the stick and deposit in the trash. Members of the Post will remove the flags for proper retirement.



United States Flag Code, Title 4, Section 8k states—"The flag, when it is in such condition that it is no longer a fitting emblem of display, should be destroyed in a dignified way, preferably by burning."

Pandemic Information

Help Us to Maintain a Safe and Healthy Return to Indoor Activities at the CBSAC

In-person activities will follow PA Department of Health & Area Agency on Aging recommendations.

- Please only come to the center when healthy. Stay home if you have had any COVID symptoms or have been in contact with anyone testing positive for COVID.
- No gathering or congregating IN THE BUILDING prior to or after activities.
- Face masks must be worn appropriately at all times and temperatures will be checked upon arrival at the center.
- Frequent hand washing is encouraged.
- Pre-registrations must be made for meals, activities & programs.

Activity Instructors will be contacting their group(s). Participants will be required to register in this manner.

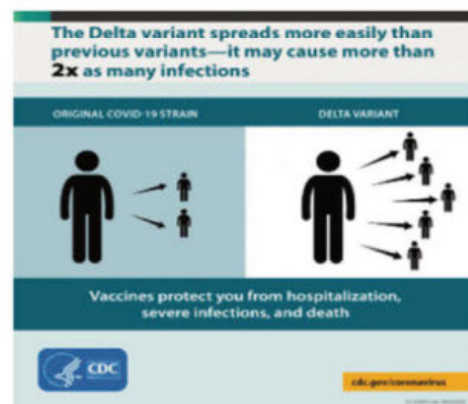
- Plan to arrive and depart promptly for activities.
- Sanitize your space prior to leaving and make it just as clean for the next person. Look for the sanitizers that are placed in each room.
- Please maintain 6 feet of distance from others.

The Center will maintain a check list which is a safety requirement from the County. Before you leave the building, please check out at the front desk to have your name crossed off the list.

Infections and Spread

The Delta variant causes more infections and spreads faster than early forms of SARS-CoV-2, the virus that causes COVID-19

- **The Delta variant is more contagious:** The Delta variant is highly contagious, more than 2x as contagious as previous variants.
- **Some data suggest the Delta variant might cause more severe illness than previous variants in unvaccinated people.** In two different studies from Canada and Scotland, patients infected with the Delta variant were more likely to be hospitalized than patients infected with Alpha or the original virus that causes COVID-19. Even so, the vast majority of hospitalization and death caused by COVID-19 are in unvaccinated people.
- **Unvaccinated people remain the greatest concern:** The greatest risk of transmission is among unvaccinated people who are much more likely to get infected, and therefore transmit the virus. Fully vaccinated people get COVID-19 (known as [breakthrough infections](#)) less often than unvaccinated people. People infected with the Delta variant, including fully vaccinated people with symptomatic breakthrough infections, can transmit the virus to others. CDC is continuing to assess data on whether fully vaccinated people with asymptomatic breakthrough infections can transmit the virus.
- **Fully vaccinated people with Delta variant breakthrough infections can spread the virus to others. However, vaccinated people appear to spread the virus for a shorter time:** For prior variants, lower amounts of viral genetic material were found in samples taken from fully vaccinated people who had breakthrough infections than from unvaccinated people with COVID-19. For people infected with the Delta variant, similar amounts of viral genetic material have been found among both unvaccinated and fully vaccinated people. However, like prior variants, the amount of viral genetic material may go down faster in fully vaccinated people when compared to unvaccinated people. This means fully vaccinated people will likely spread the virus for less time than unvaccinated people.

Meals on Wheels (a private organization) now at CBSAC

Since 1972, Meals on Wheels (MoW) of Central Bucks County has been delivering fresh, nutritious meals to home-bound people throughout our local community. To date, we have delivered over 1.3 millions meals.

Our meals are prepared fresh each day by a commercial catering service and delivered to the MoW facility within the CB Senior Activity Center in Doylestown. Each day, our volunteers package the prepared fresh food, individually sealing each one for extra safety, and put the meals in thermal bags for delivery. Our friendly volunteers deliver meals 5 days a week, Monday through Friday, providing far more than just food. They provide a kind word and a quick check in on those who live on their own.

There is lot of flexibility in the service we offer. You can sign up to receive meals 2-3 days a week if you don't need a 5 day per week plan. If you are recovering from an illness or surgery, we offer meal delivery for a limited time such as 4 -6 weeks. We'll work with you to meet your needs.

We deliver to the communities of Buckingham, Chalfont, Doylestown, Dublin, New Britain, New Hope, Nockamixon, Plumstead, Solebury, Tincum, Warrington and Warrick.

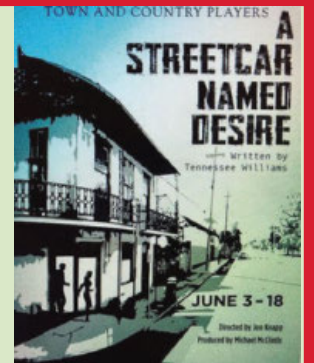
