


## **VOLUNTEER SPOTLIGHT:**






"Silent Wings: An Educational Program about Raptors" April 25th, 3:30-5pm

## The Story of the May Basket

Generations ago, children in the greater Glens Falls area would spend weeks in the spring making May Baskets. They would save old cardboard containers of all sizes and shapes, decorate them with colorful crepe paper flowers and fill them with sweets. On May 1", they would secretly place their May Baskets on doorsteps around the neighborhood.

May Baskets can be traced historically to Great Britain, where the return of spring was celebrated with singing, dancing, and an abundance of flowers. Wreaths and garlands of flowers decorated doorways, maypoles, and the local May Queen. Children presented flowers door to door, singing carols, and carrying the lady of the May, in return for small gifts or money for the church.

Over 30+ years ago, members of the Moreau 55+ Seniors, who had practiced the custom during their own childhoods and taught it to their children, began to make and sell these baskets as a fundraiser, helping to keep the tradition alive locally. Today, volunteers are welcome at the Moreau Community Center on Tuesdays at 9:30 to learn how to carry on this cherished tradition.


