Medicare beneficiaries who are interested in comparing health insurance and Part D coverage can meet with SHINE beginning 10/15 to receive cost and coverage comparisons. SHINE can assist you with dropping from one plan and enrolling in a new plan. All plans available are approved by Medicare and open enrollment ends on 12/7

If you are thinking about changing coverage, please check with doctors to see what plans they accept; obtain a current medication list with dosage or view your My Medicare account to update medications. 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
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
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
