
**Act of Spiritual Communion**

Dear Parishioners,

Now that the weather in NE Ohio is breaking (Please, God, please!) and the days are getting longer (for a while) it's time to get out and about. Last year during the quarantine, I would wander out in the evenings, walking the streets of Avon Lake. It was a good way to get exercise and to get to know the parish. I'd be out a couple hours and sometimes do five miles in an evening. I had no real plan of where to go; I'd just start out north, south, east, or west, depending on my mood. Then I made a random turn down a street. (I must confess, Google maps became a good friend to guide me home.)

This year I decided to be more intentional about walking. My goal this year is to walk every street in the parish. I'll have to map out past journeys.
