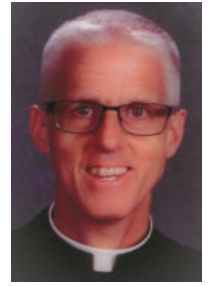

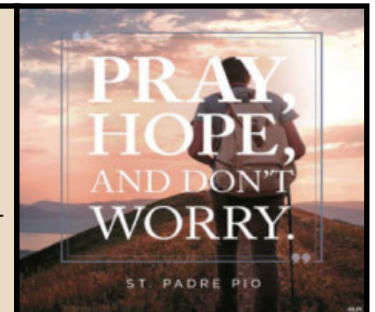
Election Prayer Service
