Fr. John's Column

What a difference a year makes! It was nice to celebrate Palm Sunday with people actually present. Over 500 attended the four weekend liturgies, by far the largest weekend number during this pandemic. Attendance at weekend Masses has grown throughout the season of Lent this year. It seems that the improving COVID numbers and the availability of vaccines has helped people become more comfortable in some crowds. We have also seen more families coming together. I will share more with you next week regarding our attendance at other Holy Week Services as well as Easter Masses. Please know that we will remain cautious as we go forward until we receive word that we can relax our restrictions. Masks and social distancing remain the norm.

If you have been to the parish recently or driven by, you may have noticed some work being done around the property. We have been replacing some sidewalks and curbing in areas where that is needed. You will be seeing work done to improve the outdoor handicap ramp that leads to the side entrance of the church from the handicap parking area. This area needs to be brought up to current code regulations. As summer approaches and our day school completes its academic year, the main parking lot will receive a major resurfacing. Both entrances to the south end of the parking lot will be included in this project along with the Parish Office parking area. This is a \$750,000.00 project and is a major part of the capital campaign we conducted in late 2019 and early 2020, just prior to the pandemic. This work as well as Centennial Park are the result of the generosity of those parishioners who have contributed to the campaign and we are all grateful. The pandemic curtailed some of the pledge drive that was nearing an end that caused us to fall short of the 3 million dollar goal. There will be other capital needs we are saving towards including replacement of roofs and HVAC equipment. Your pledges and donations are still welcome! Feel free to contact me for more details.

On behalf of the staff here at the parish, please know of our prayers for a safe and healthy Easter celebration for you and your families. May this Easter Season be a sign of hope to all of us that just as Christ rose victorious from the Cross, we, too, will rise victorious over the current challenges we are all facing at this time. **Stay safe and healthy and have a happy and blessed Easter!**

RETURN TO MASS GUIDELINES

A few important reminders:

- Masks are required to enter St. Christopher Church.
- We are now livestreaming the Saturday 5 pm Mass on our website, Facebook and YouTube.
- There remains NO Obligation to attend weekend Mass at this time.
- Please note that we are making the effort to start Mass on time and because of limited seating we are not able to seat people once Mass begins or capacity is reached. That is the reason the doors to the church are secured at that time.
- These Guidelines are to assist people attending Mass at St. Christopher. They are based on what we received from the diocese and in keeping with directives from the governor's office. The safety of all who gather here for worship is of the utmost importance.

Arriving for Mass

- The only entrance into the church during this period of time is the entrance from the main parking lot into the Upper Gathering Area. These doors are clearly marked "CHURCH".
- **Masks are required.**
- The handicap ramp is available for those who need it.
- As you enter the inside doors of the church you will need to sanitize your hands. Dispensers will be available for you to use or you may show that you are using your own.
- A collection basket is available inside the church doors if you wish to offer a contribution. There is also be a basket available as you exit. No collection is taken during Mass.

Seating

- Once inside the church, you will be escorted to your seat. In order to assure social distancing we can only use every third pew and limit the number of persons in each pew to 3 people. This number can increase slightly when family members sit together as long as they are at least 6 feet away from any non-family members.
- We estimate that we can only accommodate 100 people at any one Mass. This is why it is important that you be escorted to your pew. **Seating is significantly reduced!**
- **When the church reaches capacity or at the time that Mass begins, the doors to the church will be secured.** No one will be able to enter! This does not prevent exiting the church in anyway.
- The restrooms in the church and Parish Center will be available.

Communion

- Communion will be distributed at two stations, one in the front and one at the cross aisle. The priest or other minister will be wearing a mask. You will be invited out of your pew by an usher, form a single line, keep a 6 foot distance between communicants, receive in the hand (no gloves, please) and return by the side aisle, maintaining the 6 foot distance.
- After responding, "AMEN", then please step aside, pull down your mask, reverently place the host in your mouth, and immediately replace your mask to cover your face.

Conclusion of Mass

- At the end of Mass you may exit out the side door of the church or through the Gathering Area where you entered. We remind you to practice Social Distancing while you exit.
- Hand sanitizer will be available for those who wish to use it and bulletins will be handed to those who would like one by an usher wearing gloves.
- You will not be able to linger in the church or socialize.

Thank you for your patience as we return to worship together in these challenging days. I ask for your support and prayer as we return to our church and work together for the safety and health of all who gather for worship in our parish community.

Join us on **Monday evenings at 7:00** continuing on April 5th, for the Easter Season Sunday Gospel reflections.



EASTER BLESSINGS!

It seems that an Easter reflection should come easy. I mean, after all, Jesus overcame the sin and the work of Satan to be resurrected after three days! Why is finding something to talk about so difficult - wait, I have an idea....

What if you were Mary Magdalene and you had just gone to the burial place and Jesus was gone. She was outside of the tomb weeping but peeked her head inside and saw two angels. They asked about her weeping and she explained that "they had taken my Lord and I do not know where he is."

After saying this, she turned and saw someone but did not know who it was. Mary thought he was a gardener and he asked why she was weeping? She replied, "Sir, if you carried him away, tell me where you laid him and I will take him away." Jesus said her name, "Mary!" She turned, awestruck I'm pretty sure, and said, "Rabbouni" which means Teacher in Hebrew -he asked her to let the disciples know he was going to his Father and our Father, his God and our God.

Are you angry or anxious, untrusting and suspicious, worried or fretting all this time? Easter is your time to STOP. You'll tell me, "I can't stop, this is happening and that is happening blah blah blah blah..." I believe (I think) that I shared this story a little while back...

*"Why not?" that was the first thing he said. He had never seen me before. I hadn't said a word. "Why not?" I knew he had me. I brought up my excuses: My wife...the people I work with...not enough time...I guess it's my temperament..." There was a sword hanging on the wall. He took it and gave it to me. "Here, with this sword, you can cut through any barriers." I took it and slipped away without saying a word. Back in my room at the guesthouse I sat down and kept looking at the sword. I knew that what was said was true. But the next day I returned the sword. **How can I live without my excuses?**" (Tales of a Magic Monastery p. 86)*

Do you know someone who's life is a series of excuses or of blaming? That's a hard way to live.

It's Easter, redemption, salvation and LOVE.

Today is the first day of the rest of your life.

Unhappy, suspicious, always simmering with anger or envy? It's Easter. Look up to the sky and ask Jesus to walk with you, to help you let go of the emotional, psychological, spiritual, familial (yes, I said it) drama. Help you take what is worthwhile from your past and move on.


It's up to you.




