

I hope this New Year of 2022 is off to a good start for you and those you love. For our parish community it is our centennial year. It is a year to give thanks for the many blessings we have received and for the people who have gone before us and to look ahead as we begin a new century of service for those who will follow us. There is a Centennial Committee working to plan events to celebrate. If you would like to be of help to the committee, please let me know.

Due to early bulletin deadlines, I am writing this column on December 20th! So please forgive me for the timing of my comments. I will try to catch up next week when we return to a more normal schedule. I am simply going to point out three events that will be happening in January.



Sing to the Lord a New Song

Happy New Year! It is amazing that it is already 2022! Seems like we just celebrated the new Millennium only a few years ago, doesn't it? Remember Y2K?

While we celebrate the great feast of the Epiphany this Sunday, I want to draw our attention to yesterday, January 1 for not only was it the celebration of the new year, but it was also the celebration of the Blessed Virgin Mary, Mother of God and the annual World Day of Peace.

The World Peace Day was established by Pope St. Paul VI in his December 1967 message and celebrated for the first time in January 1968. Pope St. Paul VI noted in his first message that "The world must be educated to love peace, to build it up, and defend it." Every year thereafter on January 1, the Holy Father marks the World Day of Peace with a special message inviting all people to reflect on the important work of building peace. 


