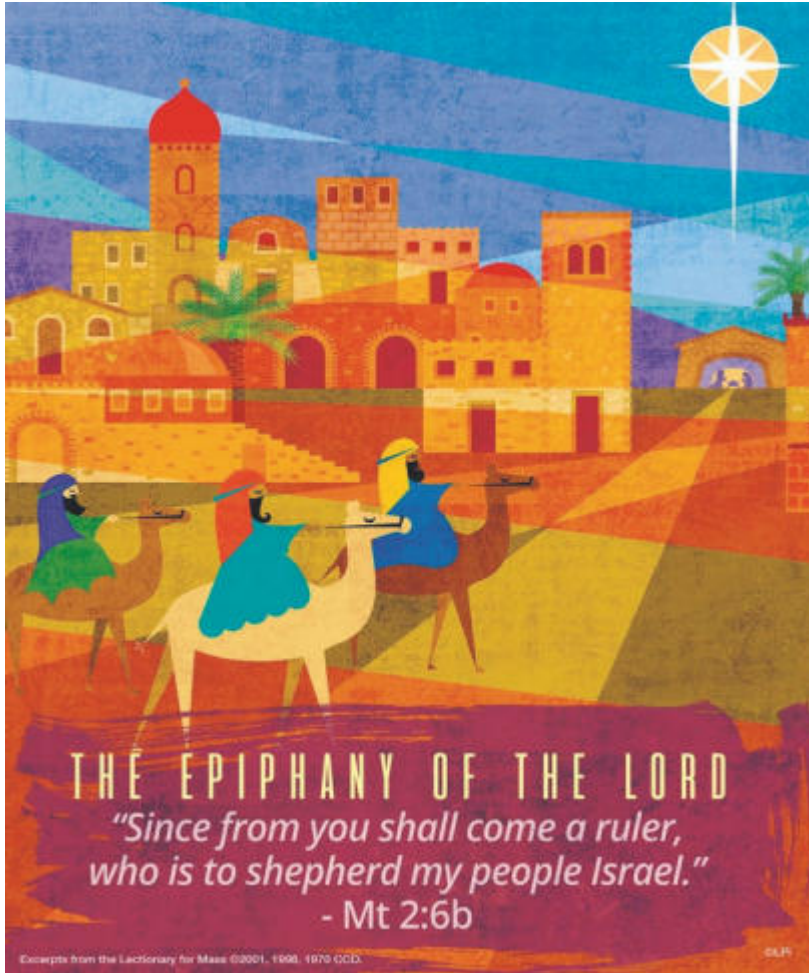

SACRAMENT OF RECONCILIATION:

SACRAMENT OF BAPTISM: Parents should be members of our parish and need to attend a pre-Baptism Class if they have not already done so. Baptisms are celebrated on Sundays beginning at 12:30 PM and other times by arrangement. Call the parish office to arrange all Baptisms.

SACRAMENT OF MARRIAGE: In keeping with Diocesan regulations, arrangements must be made with a parish priest at least 6 months before the date selected to allow for the necessary preparation.

FUNERALS: Arrangements are made with the help of a Funeral Director. They will assist in contacting the parish office to arrange a time for a Funeral Mass before any notice is placed online or in the newspaper.

RCIA: Adults interested in the Catholic faith are invited to participate in the Rite of Christian Initiation of Adults (RCIA). Meetings are Mondays from 7:00-8:30 PM beginning in the Fall and continuing through Easter. Call the parish office for details.

MINISTRY WITH THE SICK & HOMEBOUND: We are happy to bring the Eucharist or to provide the Anointing of the Sick to the homebound. Please contact the office.

PARISH REGISTRATION: New Parishioners are asked to call 440-331-4255 to set up an appointment for registration. Parishioners who are moving are also asked to notify the parish office.

PSR CLASSES: K through Grade 8: Sundays 8:30-9:30 AM and 10:00-11:00 AM. For information/registration call the Religious Ed. Office.

Fr. John's Column

I hope this New Year of 2022 is off to a good start for you and those you love. For our parish community it is our centennial year. It is a year to give thanks for the many blessings we have received and for the people who have gone before us and to look ahead as we begin a new century of service for those who will follow us. There is a Centennial Committee working to plan events to celebrate. If you would like to be of help to the committee, please let me know.

Due to early bulletin deadlines, I am writing this column on December 20th! So please forgive me for the timing of my comments. I will try to catch up next week when we return to a more normal schedule. I am simply going to point out three events that will be happening in January.

The Diocese is in the midst of an extensive study of Catholic Schools in the diocese called, ***Keeping the Faith***. During January they are holding four listening sessions designed for teachers, parents and parishioners. One of those will be held at Magnificat H.S. on Wednesday, January 19th from 6:30 to 8:00 P.M. and is open to anyone interested. There is also a virtual meeting on Wednesday, January 26th from 6:30 to 8:00 P.M. Registration is necessary only for this virtual session by emailing leppich@dioceseofcleveland.org in advance.

The entire church is invited to participate in an upcoming Synod which will focus on the three pillars of a Synodal Church: communion, participation and mission. Our Parish will host two open listening sessions on Monday, January 10 from 11:45 to 1:45pm and on Saturday, January 15 from 3pm to 5pm. Sing to the Lord a New Song

Happy New Year! It is amazing that it is already 2022! Seems like we just celebrated the new Millennium only a few years ago, doesn't it? Remember Y2K?

While we celebrate the great feast of the Epiphany this Sunday, I want to draw our attention to yesterday, January 1 for not only was it the celebration of the new year, but it was also the celebration of the Blessed Virgin Mary, Mother of God and the annual World Day of Peace.

The World Peace Day was established by Pope St. Paul VI in his December 1967 message and celebrated for the first time in January 1968. Pope St. Paul VI noted in his first message that "The world must be educated to love peace, to build it up, and defend it." Every year thereafter on January 1, the Holy Father marks the World Day of Peace with a special message inviting all people to reflect on the important work of building peace.
