

Fr. John's Column

I am finally writing a column after the Christmas Masses occurred! Bulletin deadlines made that difficult until now. I would like to begin by **thanking everyone** for your generosity to our parish over the Christmas holidays and throughout the past year. The Christmas collection is nearly \$90,000.00 so far which is less than pre-COVID times. On the other hand, donations for such areas as tuition assistance and capital needs have increased throughout the year. I am especially grateful to the increasing number of parishioners who are contributing online. If you are interested in learning more about the ease of this method of giving please visit our website or call the Parish Office.

Our Christmas Mass attendance was much better this year! The in-person total attendance for the six Masses was around 1200. That number was far better than the 250 who attended last year amidst COVID and the heavy snow that fell. Both years are much less than the 4000 people who typically worship here at St. Christopher on Christmas Eve and Christmas Day. Some 750 households tuned in to the live-streaming of the Masses for Christmas. We are very happy to be able to provide this service and even more happy that so many are watching. We will continue to live stream our Saturday evening Mass at 5:00 each weekend. I would also like to thank Logan Feldkamp, our Pastoral Minister, and our Maintenance Staff who coordinated the church decorations. Also a word of thanks to Bob McMurray, the musicians and cantors for their preparation and hard work in leading us in song.

The entire church is invited to participate in an upcoming Synod which will focus on the three pillars of a Synodal Church: communion, participation and mission. Our Parish will host two open listening sessions this week. If you are interested, simply come and join your fellow parishioners on either date in Mary's Room. Details are available elsewhere in this bulletin.


- When John baptized by Jordan's river

Sing to the Lord a New Song

Today we commemorate the Baptism of the Lord Jesus and so thereby conclude the Christmas season. The feast of Jesus' baptism is a reminder for us of our own baptism, and the great joy it is to be a Christian. In an ancient homily for Christmas, Pope St. Leo the Great (r. AD 440-461) reminded the people of God of their unique dignity rooted in baptism:

Christian, remember your dignity, and now that you share in God's own nature, do not return by sin to your former base condition. Bear in mind who is your head and of whose body you are a member. Do not forget that you have been rescued from the power of darkness and brought into the light of God's kingdom. Through the sacrament of baptism, you have become a temple of the Holy Spirit. Do not drive away so great a guest by evil conduct and become again a slave to the devil, for your liberty was bought by the Blood of Christ.

As part of our baptismal dignity, each one of us is called to participate in the life of the Church. Our Holy Father Pope Francis has invited the Catholic Church to embark on a journey together. Through listening and discernment rooted in the Holy Spirit, the entire people of God will be called to contribute to a process by which the Church deepens in understanding of her mission and looks toward the future.

A Synod, which is the process by which the Church will begin this important work is not just a convening of Bishops reflecting on a particular topic and advising the Pope. A Synod is a journey of discernment, in which the people of God are called to pray and reflect upon the Holy Spirit's will for the Church. Through our listening and our sharing, we will seek to understand what the Holy Spirit's will is for the topic being discussed – and thus, for the Church.

For the 2023 Ordinary Synod of Bishops, that topic is synodality. Simply put, synodality is discerning how the Spirit is moving through and with the Body of Christ, so that we may continue to fulfill our mission to evangelize in the world.

This week, we will have two opportunities to gather for these synod listening sessions: **Monday, January 10 at 11:45AM in Mary's Room** following the 11AM Mass and **Saturday, January 15 at 3PM in Mary's Room** ending with the 5PM Mass. Please consider joining either of these listening sessions. I look forward to a great participation of our parishioners. Amen!



ROCKY RIVER ASSISTANCE PROGRAM




