

# Sing to the Lord a New Song

Tomorrow, as a nation we commemorate the Reverend Dr. Martin Luther King, Jr in gratitude for the work he did to promote the dignity of every human person, regardless of the color of one's skin. As he reminded the nation in his *Letter from Birmingham Jail:* "Injustice anywhere is a threat to justice everywhere. We are caught in an inescapable network of mutuality, tied in a single garment of destiny. Whatever affects one directly, affects all indirectly."

The Church firmly teaches us that racism is a sin because it rejects God's beauty in creating each human being wonderfully in His image and likeness: "Racism rejects what God has done by refusing to acknowledge the image of God in the other, the stranger, and the one who is different. The fact that we were created in the image of God should remind us that each person is a living expression of God that must be respected and preserved and never dishonored," (USCCB).

In point of fact, in 1979 the US Bishops reminded the nation that "The United States of America rests on a constitutional heritage that recognizes the equality, dignity, and inalienable rights of all its citizens. Further, we are heirs of a religious teaching which proclaims that all men and women, as children of God, are brothers and sisters. Every form of discrimination against individuals and groups – whether because of race, ethnicity, religion, gender, economic status, or national or cultural origin— is a serious injustice which has severely weakened our social fabric and deprived our country of the unique contributions of many of our citizens," (*Pastoral Letter on Racism*).

In remembrance of the Reverend Dr. Martin Luther King, Jr. and his work to end racism, consider rereading his remarkable *Letter from Birmingham Jail* and be sure to visit the US Bishops' web site which has further reflections and action steps to combat the evil of racism: **usccb.org/racism**


#### FIT FROM FAITH WELLNESS WORKSHOP


