

Fr. John's Column

As you are undoubtedly aware, **the upcoming election on November 7**th includes an important issue that needs careful study and understanding. Issue 1 is a proposed amendment to the Ohio Constitution that would endanger the health and safety of women, threaten parental rights, and allow for abortion through all nine months of pregnancy. Included in the bulletin today is more detailed information regarding this amendment. A second part was included in last week's bulletin and both pages are available in hard copy at all our exits. These fact sheets have been prepared by the Catholic Conference of Ohio. You can also visit their website www.ohiocathconf.org/protect for more information.

I want to remind you about the opportunity to again donate towards the Angel Scholarship Fund. This program in the State of Ohio began last year allowing donors to qualify for an Ohio State tax credit when doing their taxes. This has helped many families in our school with tuition expenses for the 2023 - 2024 school year. This tax credit will continue in the current tax year. We encourage you to take advantage of this opportunity to help support Catholic schools. This tax law allows you to take a 100% Ohio income tax credit of up to \$750.00 against your 2023 state tax liability and can really help our parish and school! In other words, the state of Ohio allows you to "spend" some of the state income taxes you must pay anyway to provide tuition assistance for students seeking an education at St. Chris. Sing to the Lord a New Song

The month of October is dedicated to the Holy Rosary. It is a perfect time to renew one of the most cherished prayers and devotions of the Church, especially as a family. I must admit that growing up, the Rosary was not particularly my favorite prayer. I found it boring, and was frustrated when one of my grandmothers would want to pray it with me. Now, however, I carry a Rosary in my pocket and pray it with joy whenever I have the chance; still not daily, but that is my goal. Perhaps you, too, have come to cherish the Rosary as a favorite devotional prayer. When I visit our sisters and brothers in nursing homes or the homebound, they usually will tell me that the Rosary is their only regular connection to the Church, and that the Virgin Mary's prayers for them become their hope and joy.

Sometime back Pope Francis made this appeal: "Especially during this month of October, I invite everyone to rediscover the beauty of praying the Rosary, which has nourished the faith of Christian people throughout the centuries."

If you have forgotten how to pray the Rosary, our US Bishops have a handy online guide to assist at **usccb.org/how-to-pray-the-rosary** It is a step-by-step process that can be printed out or used on one's smartphone. The important thing to remember when praying the Rosary is that it is a prayer from the heart, and the mechanics of it are simply a tool to aid our contemplation of a particular mystery.

Finally, in 2018, Pope Francis encouraged the faithful to conclude the recitation of the Rosary with the Church's oldest prayer to the Virgin Mary – *Sub Tuum Praesidium* – and with the prayer to Saint Michael Archangel. Printed below is the English translation of both prayers.

Sub Tuum Praesidium

We fly to your protection,
O Holy Mother of God.
Do not despise our petitions in our necessities,
but deliver us always from all dangers,
O Glorious and Blessed Virgin.
Amen!


PRE-BAPTISM CLASS FOR NEW PARENTS Sunday, October 29 @ 12:30 in the Atrium



WHERE DOES IT SAY THAT?



THIS CONSTITUTIONAL AMENDMENT...

THREATENS PARENTAL RIGHTS

By using "individual" instead of adult or woman, anyone under the age of 18 could have an abortion or make any other reproductive decision without their parents' consent or notification.

PUTS WOMEN AT RISK

Current Ohio laws* require abortion providers to explain procedure risks and ensure access to hospital transfer if needed. These health and safety standards could be seen as a "burden" and be eliminated, making it even less safe for women seeking an abortion.

ALLOWS ABORTIONS THROUGH 9 MONTHS OF PREGNANCY

In U.S. law,** "health" includes age or physical, emotional, or psychological well-being. This means a woman's age or emotional health could be cited to justify aborting a full-term baby. An abortionproviding physician would decide when a baby could survive outside the womb, leaving no clear protections for preborn children.

IS MISLEADING

Referring to "miscarriage care" promotes a myth that a "right to abortion" is necessary to preserve care for miscarriages and ectopic pregnancies. This is false. Catholic hospitals have always provided comprehensive miscarriage care and will continue to do so regardless of the outcome of this vote.

ARTICLE I, SECTION 22

The Right to Reproductive Freedom with Protections for Health and Safety

- Every individual has a right to make and carry out one's own reproductive decisions, including but not limited to decisions on contraception, fertility treatment, continuing one's own pregnancy, miscarriage care, and abortion.
- The State shall not, directly or indirectly, burden, penalize, prohibit, interfere with, or discriminate against either an individual's voluntary exercise of this right or a person or entity that assists an individual exercising this right, unless the State demonstrates that it is using the least restrictive means to advance the individual's health in accordance with widely accepted and evidence-based standards of care.
- However, abortion may be prohibited after fetal viability. But in no case may such an abortion be prohibited if in the professional judgment of the pregnant patient's treating physician it is necessary to protect the pregnant patient's life or health.
- 4. As used in this Section, "Fetal viability" means "the point in a pregnancy when, in the professional judgment of the pregnant patient's treating physician, the fetus has a significant likelihood of survival outside the uterus with reasonable measures. This is determined on a case-by-case basis"; and "State" includes any governmental entity and political subdivision.
- 5. This Section is self-executing.






