

FOCUSING ON THE GOSPEL BY SISTER VERNA HOLYHEAD, SGS

Key words and phrases: "Peter and his companions had been overcome by sleep, but becoming fully awake, they saw his glory and the two men standing with him."

This was probably an awesome and terrifying scene for Peter, John, and James. They wake up and their friend Jesus is talking with long-dead heroes, in a cloud of glory. It's almost as if they stumbled into a private meeting of the divine. Peter's reaction is rash, but not illogical; he suggests building tents (what we would call altars) to honor the three superheroes standing in front of him. What else could he do? We get another encounter with Peter's humanity when Luke tells us, "But he did not know what he was saying."

Have you ever been excited? We call life-changing experiences "mountaintop" experiences because of this gospel passage. Whether it's a retreat or a vacation, it's the mountaintop experiences that give us the inspiration and courage to carry on with regular life.

Ukraine. SVdP will also donate any contribution received in the month of March to this diocesan campaign.




"Lenten Day of Devotion"
