A NOTE FROM FR. SHERIDAN

Dear Brothers and Sisters in Christ,



The word Lent comes from an old English word meaning springtime. In Latin and the other romance languages, the word for Lent comes from the word for forty (*Quadragesima*), signifying the forty days in the desert. I think, to get a fuller understanding of the season of

Lent, it is helpful to consider both of these origins. During this time of forty days, we enter into the desert with the Lord. Here in this Lenten desert, like Him, we fast and pray; and here, like Him, we will be tempted. The fasting, prayer, and almsgiving we undertake during this Holy Season, will help us to restrain our faults and build up strength, so that the virtues may grow in us. Thus, Lent is a season of renewal, a springtime in the Spiritual Life. As we take on these penitential practices, we seek to root out from within us all that is evil, and we turn back to the Lord, who is mercy itself. May this Lenten Season be a time of grace for each of us, so that we can be renewed in the Spiritual Life, and recommit our lives to the Lord.

This weekend I will be celebrating the Masses as Guardian Angels Parish in Canton, where I am currently the administrator *pro-tempore*. Fr. Lanterman, our parochial vicar, will be celebrating all the Masses here at Divine Mercy Parish. Please pray for all our priests, active and retired, so that the Lord will bless us with strength and perseverance for the tasks entrusted to us as we minister to the Flock of the Lord. Also, please pray for vocations to the priesthood and religious life, that the Lord will send abundant laborers into the vineyard for the harvest.

As you know, the Fridays of Lent, as penitential days, are to be observed as days of abstinence from meat for all Catholics who are 14 years old or older. So, if you are struggling to find out what to eat for your dinner on a Friday of Lent, consider joining us for the Fish Fry at Saint Mary School, dine in or drive thru, from 4:30 PM to 7:00 PM.

Thanks to those of you who have already responded so generously to the Diocesan Annual Appeal. After just one weekend, we are already at \$16,300 pledged toward our parish's goal of \$157,000. We are well on our way to achieving our goal due to the gifts you have committed. If you have not yet received a letter from the bishop at home, please take an envelope from the pew in the church today and pray about how you can help us meet the needs of the poor and vulnerable among us, as we seek to serve them, One in Hope and One in Mission.

Our sympathies are with the families and friends of the

recently deceased members of Divine Mercy Parish: Shirley Miller and Thomas Busby. May the Lord, in His love and mercy, welcome them into heaven as He provides comfort and consolation to those who mourn their passing.

This course is designed to help adult Catholics in strengthening our faith and assisting us in defending it and sharing it with others. We will examine the teaching of the Church on an array of issues, from belief in God and His Self-Revelation to us in Jesus Christ to the practice of the faith in the liturgical life, the moral life, and the life of prayer, this course will show that faith must be put into action.






