**FROM THE DESK OF DR. MEGAN LOWES-BOLIN,**

Happy Memorial Day Weekend!

On behalf of the St. Adalbert Parish staff, we would like to thank all those who have served our country. Those who are currently with us on earth, or with our Heavenly Father, we are thankful for the dedication and service to keep our country safe!

As we observe Memorial Day weekend, we find ourselves beginning to transition from the busyness and routine of the school year/work year, to looking ahead to summer and everything that it has in store for us. During this time of transition from one season to the other, it is important for us to remember that even during the summer or times of break from the busyness of life, we are to stay true to the mission God has for us. Additionally, we are called to spread the good news of the Gospel and help others come to know and experience the love of Jesus Christ.

In today's Gospel, we hear about the commissioning of the disciples. Matthew 28:19-20 reads as follows:

*Go, therefore, and make disciples of all nations, baptizing them in the name of the Father, and of the Son, and of the Holy Spirit, teaching them to observe all that I have commanded you.*

What does it mean to go and make disciples of all the nations? What can we do as an individual to help others come to know and experience the love of Jesus?

This passage from the Gospel is Jesus instructing his disciples to go out into the world and help people come to know who God is. Remember, the followers of Jesus were common people (i.e., fishermen, tax collectors...etc.). They were not necessarily "experts" but rather people called to help share the good news of Christ.


God does not call the equip; rather he equips the called!

God gives us the tools to be able to go out into the world and help others encounter Christ. These tools can come in the form of our gifts and talents which can be used to help others experience the love of God.

When working with our Confirmation students, I always challenge them to think about the gifts and talents they have in their lives. What God has blessed them with and what they are good at. This past year, many of our Confirmation students often shared

that they were involved with sports. Through reflection, the students have recognized how using their gift of athleticism has helped them give someone else the opportunity to come to know who Christ is, whether it is being nice to a teammate or being present for them during a difficult time. One of the Confirmation students shared how they had open conversations about their faith with one of their teammates which led to that individual starting to attend Mass.

We do not always know the day and time God will call us to serve. However, when we remain open to God working through us, incredible things will happen! We may not always see the fruits of our labor but planting the seeds can help make a difference in the lives of others.


