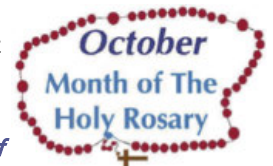
Schedule of Blessings




St. Paul's Parishioners generously contributed \$3,030 for Bishop's Relief to support our brothers and sisters in the Southwestern areas of our Diocese suffering from the damage caused by Hurricane Helene.

As many are aware, the lightning strike in a thunderstorm July 30th damaged the HVAC system in the Sanctuary and our livestreaming system, totaling \$9,788.49 in damage. With a \$2,500 deductible, we received an insurance payment of \$7,288.49.

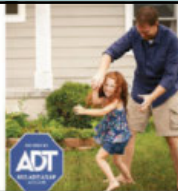
