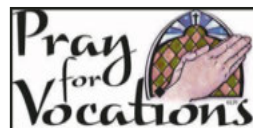

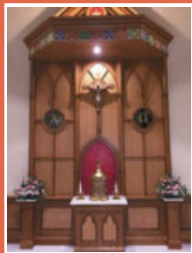


Heavenly Father,

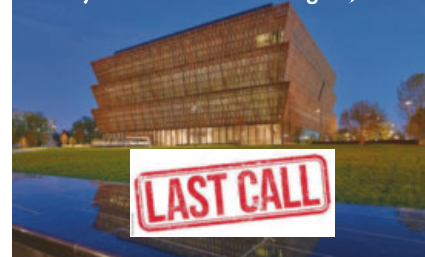

MINISTRY TO HOMEBOUND PARISHIONERS

Prior to COVID, the parish had an active ministry to homebound parishioners.

COVID restrictions prevented this ministry from continuing.

The parish is now looking to restart this valuable ministry.

How can you help?

You can assist in this ministry in two ways:

1. By volunteering to **visit** homebound parishioners and, if they choose, distribute Holy Communion to them. You will be trained in the proper way to distribute Holy Communion. The visits can, but need not, take place on a Sunday. You can volunteer to visit as often as you like and to visit as many parishioners as you like. In other words, we will tailor your participation in the ministry to your availability.

2. By volunteering to make **phone calls** to check on and talk with homebound parishioners. Again, you can volunteer to make as many calls as you like to as many people as you like.

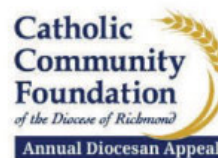
