Contact the office and make an appointment with a priest at least six months before the wedding date.



GOSPEL MEDITATION - ENCOURAGE DEEPER UNDERSTANDING OF SCRIPTURE

October 20, 2024 29th Sunday in Ordinary Time

From a young age, I loved winning at sports. I confess that winning was a bit of an addiction. It was probably coming from a deep desire for attention and affirmation from others. Nevertheless, it was a driving motivation for me. Baseball, soccer, track, table tennis, and whatever else I could find was a chance to win. Competition was my obsession.

Another John, and his brother James, demonstrate a kind of wildly competitive obsession when they dare to say to Jesus: "Grant us to sit, one at your right hand and one at your left, in your glory" (Mark 10:37). Their audacity arouses an indigent reaction from the other apostles, who are clearly raw that these two are out to win the highest spots.

How does Jesus respond to us in our desires for greatness? The same way he does to James and John. He does not criticize them for their desire for glory. But he does highlight their ignorance ("you do not know what you are asking."). Then he invites them to be champions of true greatness: by drinking not the cup of worldly victory, but his cup of self-giving suffering love, to be the "slave of all." The true winners are slaves of love. This week, dare to tell Jesus what your ambitions truly are. Hear him call you to an even greater victory.

From the Notes on Prayer by Pope Francis "Where two or three are gathered in my name" (Mt 18:20): the meaning of spiritual retreat

By saying the "Our Father" we are brought closer and closer to the heart of God and the heart of our faith.

Through the Holy Father's catechesis, he leads

us to understand that this prayer is not a mere set of words and needs, but a pathway toward intimacy with our Heavenly Father. It teaches us to address God in filial trust, calling him "Father" in simplicity and love. There is no need -says the Pope – 'to multiply empty words' (General Audience, February 27, 2019): Jesus teaches us what is essential. He shows us that we can speak to the Father with simplicity of heart, because He 'knows what you need even before you ask Him' (Mt. 6:8). Traditionally, the Lord's Prayer is made up of seven parts, also called 'the seven petitions', to which the Catechism of the Catholic Church devotes (Nos 2803-2854). It summarizes the very spirit of the Christian faith in the relationship that each believer is called to have with the Heavenly Father. These seven petitions could be used as an outline for monthly retreats leading up to the Jubilee as a part of the School of Prayer, by dedicating each retreat to one part of the prayer that Jesus taught us.
