If you have ever planned a large-scale event, whether it's a musical performance or a religious conference, you may have dealt with someone's personal assistant. Possibly this person would be a representative of the keynote speaker or the master of ceremonies for the local bishop; perhaps it's even the staffer of a local politician or the lackey of a well-known musical act.

Personal assistants are masters of stewardship — overseeing things in their boss' absence. They prepare the way. This person's job is to get everything ready for the person in charge, so that when he or she shows up — whoever he or she is — it's smooth sailing for them to do whatever it is they need to do: sing, speak, pray, mingle, what-have-you. It's usually a big job full of little things, a gig where attention to detail is key.

God is the guest of honor in our life, the keynote speaker, the main event. And what He wants — what He needs — to do is to change our hearts. Constantly, over, and over, and over again.

We are all His personal assistants in this endeavor. We need to prepare the way of the Lord, to make straight His paths. 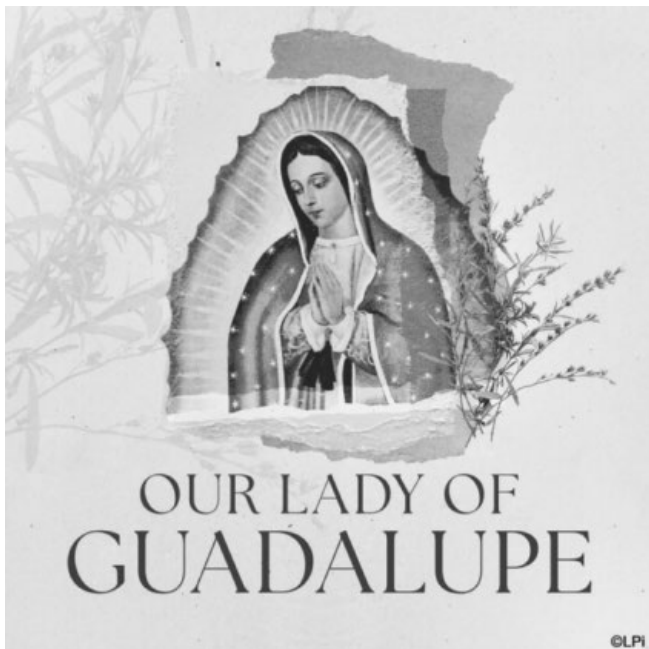

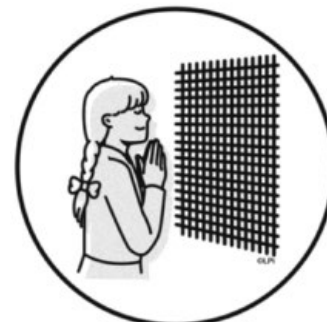

The “Simbang Gabi,” also known as Misa de Gallo is an ancient but little-known custom of preparing for the coming of the Child Jesus. It is a long-treasured and cherished Philippine tradition, originally a series of “dawn masses” for nine consecutive days before Christmas Day. Its liturgical significance emanates from the Season of Advent, being the time of spiritual preparation and purification to welcome and receive the Child Jesus in our midst. The Mass at Dawn, “Simbang Gabi”, is a profound expression of Marian Devotion because we join Mary in joyful expectation of the coming of Jesus. It starts every December 16th and is one of the oldest and most important religious celebrations in the Philippines before Christmas. Here in the United States, Filipino immigrants brought with them this distinct tradition which has planted deep roots in many states like California, New York, Chicago, New Jersey, and in Virginia, receiving a strong and unequivocal support by the bishop of the Diocese of Richmond and the Office of Ethnic Ministries.

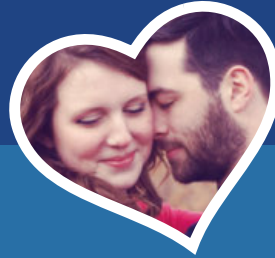
