Fr. Ron's Corner

We read in our Gospel passage this weekend how the people in Jesus' native place did not have faith in Him: "Jesus said to them, 'A prophet is not without honor except in his native place and among his own kin and in his own house.' So he was not able to perform any mighty deed there, apart from curing a few sick people by laying his hands on them. He was amazed at their lack of faith." This week's gospel is in stark contrast to the Gospel proclaimed the last few weekends. It is our faith in Jesus that saves us. Have you been working on your relationship with Jesus?

We are blessed that we can once again celebrate our Independence Day. As I have mentioned before, I prefer to refer to this civil holiday for its reason (Independence Day) not by its date (4th of July). By doing so we remember and celebrate the insight and wisdom of our country's founders and those who defended this declaration and fought and offered their lives in the Revolutionary War which began in 1754 and ended in 1783. We need to continue to pray for our country and its democracy. Independence Day Mass is typically hosted at Holy Spirit Parish. They will observe the Civil Holiday Mass for Independence Day on Monday, July 5 at 8:30am. Because of livestream worshipers, we will also have our Monday 8am Mass for the 14th week of Ordinary Time.



As you have all noticed, our north parking lot is open and finished! The project went very smoothly and considering the rainy weather we had in the months of May and June, it came together in perfect time. We will be adding the finishing touches of lighting, directional signage, and landscaping over time. We hope you enjoy this huge capital improvement as much as we do! It has been a fun project to watch over the last 8 weeks. I am so grateful to all of you who donated and continue to fulfill your pledges to our capital campaign. Completed projects such as the parking lot benefits our entire Parish community as well as the many guests and visitors we are expecting to have later this summer at our festival, CYO games, and even the school buses and car transportation lines. This project really ties together our faith, our family, and our future so I thank you from the bottom of my heart for your ongoing support.

Many have been inquiring about the status of Fr. Jim Becherer's Estate Sale. Fr. Becherer held St. Joseph Parish and School very close to his heart. He made a very specific request for things to be done in a certain way after his death. One of the most important things to him was to make sure that we at St. Joseph Parish and School were the recipients of the monies from his estate sale. We have spent the last few months preparing the items and safely moving everything from his home to our campus so that everything is secured.



We invite you to come and tour the items that will be up for auction in Fr. Becherer's estate sale on Saturday and Sunday, July 17 & 18 following all weekend Masses. We will also have the items up online for preview as well on Friday, August 16 at 1pm. We will be using our Give Smart Platform, that we use annually for our Parish School Auction. This link will allow anyone to look at the items so that they can be prepared for what items they would like to bid on. There are over 250 items that are going to be auctioned off, so we felt that this was the best way for those who might be interested to view items beforehand no matter where they might live (Fr. Becherer had friends all over the country!).

Everyone is able to begin bidding on the items. Online bidding will be open until midnight on Friday, July 23. Once bidding closes and winners have been determined, all items MUST be picked up from St. Joseph Hall on Saturday and Sunday, July 24 & 25. If you are out of town and need something shipped, we will work with you to make those arrangements. Please remember that all shipping fees and arrangements are to be made at the buyer's expense. We are not responsible for moving, packing, or transporting of any items off our property.
