Fr. Ron's Corner

Since Father Ron was away this week, we wanted to provide you with a bit of information regarding Ash Wednesday services: While ash Wednesday is not a holy day of obligation we encourage you to attend an in-person mass of your choice. If not please take an opportunity at home to pray together at home and to mark yourself with ashes.

Ashes to Ashes: Wednesday, March 2 is Ash Wednesday; there are several ways your family can celebrate this beginning of Lent:

- **Ash Wednesday Mass:** There will be Ash Wednesday Masses with ash distribution both here and at Holy Spirit. See our Parish website or the bulletin for the Mass schedule.
- **DIY Ash Wednesday Service at Home:** Again this year, will offer ashes to take home to your family in the Gathering Area. We will provide a small plastic cup with ashes as well as a bookmark with directions on how to conduct an ash distribution service at home and how to properly dispose of the ashes. It is a blessing that ash distribution is something that can be done by a person with the proper disposition and a priest is not necessary.

"Sacraments" vs. "Sacramentals": Ashes are a sacramental. One way to think about the difference between sacraments and sacramentals is that they are simply 2 different levels at which we can receive the grace of God in our lives ("grace" meaning the presence of God). The primary way that God wishes to enter our life is through the sacraments, and because of that Jesus himself acts through an ordained Priest who stands in the person of Christ to administer the sacrament. When a sacrament is being performed, you could imagine that it is not the priest who is standing there but Jesus himself! We receive the presence of God in a way that is unique and primary through the sacraments of Baptism, Reconciliation, Confirmation, Eucharist, Marriage, Holy Orders, or Anointing of the Sick. But we can also receive the presence of God through what are called "sacramentals."

The key difference is that we are asking God to bless this person, object, or place when we perform some sacramental. As opposed to a sacrament where Jesus is acting through the ordained Priest to confer blessing. They are simply 2 different levels of receiving God's blessing! Sacramentals do flow from sacraments, and then also guide us back to the sacraments. Some examples of other sacramentals are palms, grace before meals, genuflecting, the sign of the cross, incense, a rosary, a crucifix, scapulars, medals, statues, holy cards, and more. This is a great opportunity for you to put into practice your common priesthood of all the baptized!

It is easy to forget that at our baptism we are all anointed as "priest, prophet, and king." Specific people are called to be ordained Priests, but there is a common priesthood of all Christians that we are called to put into practice! One of the duties of our common priesthood is to offer sacrifice to God and to allow God to bless others through us. One primary way this is done is through blessings which incorporate "sacramentals." A sacramental normally includes prayers accompanied by a specific physical sign, such as the tracing of ashes on the forehead of a person.

DISPOSAL OF LEFTOVER ASHES

Please remember that any leftover ashes cannot be thrown away in the trash or rinsed down the drain. Simply just dump the remaining ashes into your garden or grass.

Please keep the plastic bag that your ashes came in, and use it to safely return your palms from last year so that they can be burned and used to make ashes for next year. Please return them any time before Palm Sunday in the Gathering Area.

As everyone knows, we have a very busy Lenten season at our parish. While it is meant to be a time of scaling back and simplicity, we invite you to join us for our first Lenten Friday next week! We will have our annual Fish Fry and Stations of the Cross.

We look forward to celebrating the season of Lent with you this year. May you know God's Blessings!

We have been getting calls from parishioners who have noticed that their automatic giving stopped and they don't know why. One of the reasons is if you have signed up for auto-giving via credit card and have a received a new credit card because it was about to expire or it has been reissued, please submit either a new authorization form to St. Joseph or update your giving information on-line. Although the credit card number may have remained the same, the 3-digit CVV number on the back has changed and without that new number your automatic donation can not be processed.

What is Tuition Assistance?
