



### MASS SCHEDULE CHANGE COMING SOON!

### SOCIAL JUSTICE MINISTRY CORNER

"There is a nobility in the duty to care for creation through little daily actions, and it is wonderful how education can bring about real changes in lifestyle." Pope Francis' Laudato Si', #211

Laudato Si' is the name of the encyclical that Pope Francis issued in 2015, and in it he appeals to all people for a dialogue about how we are caring for creation. Pope Francis calls the Church and the world to acknowledge the urgency of our environmental challenges and to join him in embarking on a new path. Beginning today is Laudato Si' Week 2022, an observance by the Catholic Church around the world to mark the seventh anniversary of the encyclical. How critical it is that each of us 1.3 billion Catholics around the world, and the rest of humankind, too, listens and responds to the cry of God's creation. Considering that the Church embraces nearly 20 percent of the world's population, it can play a powerful role in solving the dual challenges of the climate emergency and ecological crisis.

The theme for the week is "Listening and Journeying Together." Each day of the week will be highlighted by a global event held in-person, online, or a combination of the two. The events will lift up Catholic teaching on biodiversity, responding to the cry of the poor, divestment, education, and eco-spirituality. Laudato Si' is Italian for "praise be to you" and is a quotation from St. Francis of Assisi's "Canticle of the Creatures". In it the saint praises God by meditating on the goodness of sun, wind, Earth, water, and other natural forces. To learn more about the Laudato Si'movement, see https://www.laudatosi.va/en.html.

One way our diocese is participating in Laudato Si' Week 2022 is through a presentation called, "Environmental Symptoms of Racial Disparity in NE Ohio: Environmental Equity and Practical Ways to Respond as Parishes, Schools and Individuals". This event will occur via Zoom on Monday, May 23, from 7-8:30 p.m. Kim Foreman, executive director for Environmental Health Watch, will be the speaker. She will help us to see how ecology and race impact each other, tell us about local efforts to address environmental racism, and offer ways that parishes, schools, and individuals can make a difference.
