This trip was originally scheduled for April of 2020, but because of the pandemic, it was rescheduled for the Spring of 2021, Fall of 2021 and now we are enjoying Israel in the Spring of 2022. By God's grace, Fr. Ron will be in the Holy Land on May 30. May 30 is his 30th Anniversary of priesthood. What a way to celebrate! God is so good. The Scots Hotel has an interesting history: first serving the people of Galilee as a hospital and now as a guest house for Christian pilgrims. The hotel is beautiful and is situated upon the shores of Galilee, and still owned and operated by the Church of Scotland.



We traveled to Mount Carmel and visited Stella Maris, a Carmelite Monastery. We celebrated mass there and then headed to Bahja Gardens. Afterwards, we traveled to the Mediterranean Coast to the Ancient City of Caesarea, once the capital of the Roman province. This is the place where St. Paul was taken in chains to Rome and where Peter baptized one of the first Gentiles, Cornelius.

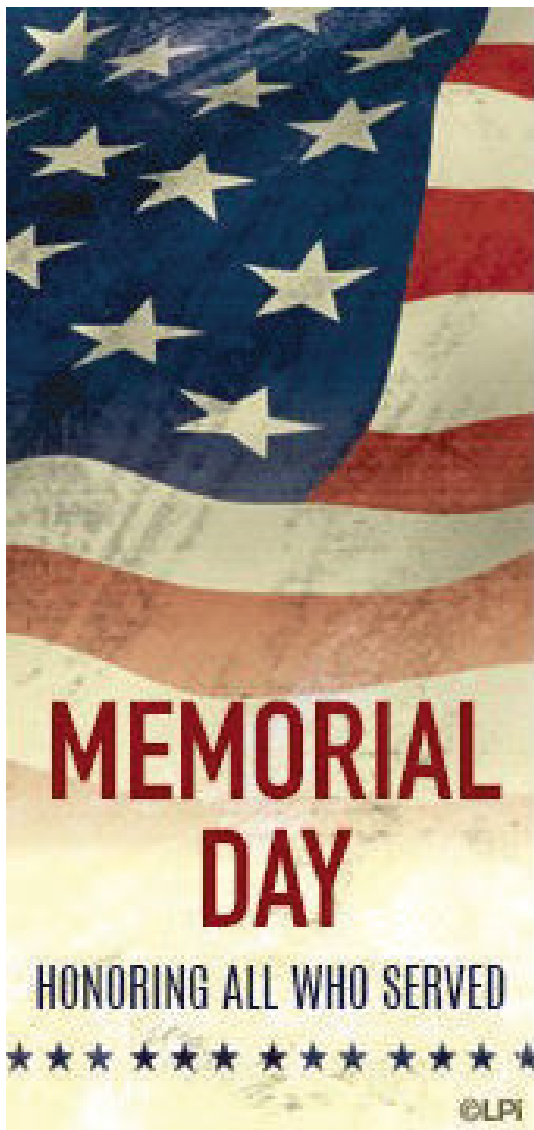

SOCIAL JUSTICE MINISTRY CORNER

"The Diocese of Cleveland's Catholic Charities Migration and Refugee Services (MRS) has now resettled about 270 refugees, with 50 more arriving between now and September. Holy Spirit and St. Joseph parishes have helped to meet the needs of these brothers and sisters of ours, and our parishes' join Social Justice Ministry is very grateful for your response to its Helping Hands project. It brought in many donations of household items for refugee families.

If you are in a position to offer as little as an hour a week for three months, you can assist these people in another way. Such a commitment would make it possible for you to serve as a mentor for a family as they adjust to their new life here. You could do so as an individual, a couple, or as a group that would share in this effort. A mentor helps a new family map out their neighborhood, practice their English, and connect to resources, like the public library system.
