Fr. Ron's Corner

This weekend we begin our trek through ordinary time. We hear in today's Gospel the "cost" of following Jesus. "As they were proceeding on their journey someone said to him, "I will follow you wherever you go." Jesus answered him, "Foxes have dens and birds of the sky have nests, but the Son of Man has nowhere to rest his head." And to another he said, "Follow me." But he replied, "Lord, let me go first and bury my father." But he answered him, "Let the dead bury their dead. But you, go and proclaim the kingdom of God." And another said, "I will follow you, Lord, but first let me say farewell to my family at home." To him Jesus said, "No one who sets a hand to the plow and looks to what was left behind is fit for the kingdom of God." Luke 9:51-42 On our own, we might feel overwhelmed by the responsibilities of missionary discipleship. You may have also noticed that all the original lighting fixtures that illuminated the have been replaced with more energy efficiency LED lighting. The church buildings are now bathed in a beautiful white light. The outdoor lighting

replacement concludes our 75th anniversary church lighting project. You can see photos on both the front of the bulletin as well as below. We will begin work on the final project of the 75th Anniversary Campaign, the social hall carpet replacement, over the next few weeks. Thank you to all who donated!

We will report on all of our fundraising efforts in our Annual Stewardship Report, but we have received a couple of inquiries regarding the proceeds from our annual fish fries. This year we raised \$44,134. Again, thank you so much to all those who make this beautiful Lenten tradition possible.

Thank you for all your birthday wishes. I had a wonderful 60th birthday celebration this past Wednesday, June 22. You can view a few photos on page 8 of the bulletin from a surprise staff celebration that was held at Parker's. The finance council was very generous in cancelling our meeting for that evening, so some of them were in attendance to celebrate with me. Don't contribute to landfill: Refuse and reuse!




