

Fr. Ron's Corner

Hopefully you have noticed our new inspirational and directional signage. I was inspired by the messaging that was present at Camp Damascus, a Catholic youth camp north of Columbus. I first visited a few years ago, while our 6th graders attended a faith and science experience as part of their day school retreat experience. St. Paul, the Apostle is their patron saint; his life and the scriptures he left us are the inspiration for Camp Damascus. I connected with their mission because I believe it ties so nicely to our parish priority plan of forming missionary disciples. We crafted the parish Vision and Action Plan as we celebrated our 70th Anniversary. We outlined our vision of Encounter, Accompaniment, Community and Sending by capturing ways we might enliven that vision here at St. Joseph Parish and School. We concluded the plan with this Vision Statement: "St. Joseph Parish and School is One Family in Christ who encounters Jesus, accompanies one another, forms community and is sent for to live the Gospel." As I have mentioned many times, Jesus himself is the crafter of the "discipleship maker" method. People encountered Him, He accompanied them in their faithful journey, which formed community to send the good news into the world — just like in today's Gospel.

We read in Luke 10: 1-12 "At that time the Lord appointed seventy-two others whom he sent ahead of him in pairs to every town and place he intended to visit. He said to them, "The harvest is abundant but the laborers are few; so ask the master of the harvest to send out laborers for his harvest. Go on your way; behold, I am sending you like lambs

among wolves. Carry no money bag, no sack, no sandals; and greet no one along the way. Into whatever house you enter, first say, 'Peace to this household.' If a peaceful person lives there, your peace will rest on him; but if not, it will return to you." Just like the 72 we are sent.

I will be on retreat from July 5 to July 12 at the Jesuit Retreat Center in Parma. The format of the retreat is an Ignatian 8 day retreat, which is silent with a daily hourly meeting to provide "direction." The director is not doing the directing, that is the work of the Holy Spirit. The Director helps the retreatant discern the movements of the Holy Spirit in his or her retreat experience. St. Ignatius recommends 8 days so that one's mind can quiet, God's presence can be felt, and growth in one's relationship with the Lord can occur. Please keep me in your prayers while I am on retreat.

Next weekend, we will be hosting Fr. Matthew. He is from the Diocese of Yaounde in Camaroon (Africa). They have a diocesan program where they use these raised funds to support the local villages, especially in regards to providing clean water and supporting the mothers and orphans. Will be taking a 2nd collection to help support his ministry. Can people donate on line? How will that be made available etc. I know you will great him with our usual St. Joseph Parish and School hospitality.





Thank you for all the many ways you serve the poor. Our CRS bag snack bag collection was a big success and our outreach to those in need in Lorain county continues each week.

Enjoy your celebrating our nations Independence.

SOCIAL JUSTICE MINISTRY CORNER Use a Composter

"As stewards of God's creation, we are called to make the earth a beautiful garden for the human family. When we destroy our forests, ravage our soil and pollute our seas, we betray that noble calling."

Garbage does not readily decompose or enrich the soil inside landfills because modern landfills are airtight, sealing out the oxygen that is needed by bacteria. With a composter you can turn your food and yard waste into black gold that will feed your vegetable and flower gardens. Using a composter also reduces methane emissions produced by landfills. If you are concerned about attracting critters, many styles of compost containers are designed to discourage unwanted pests. You can purchase indoor composters and worm farms if you do not have a place for outdoor composting. There is even a Japanese method of composting in a cardboard box that you can keep in your living room. There are numerous online sources of information on how to compost. For example, see https://www.nytimes.com/2020/05/06/climate/nyt-climate-newsletter-composting-coronavirus.html. You might also discover that your friends have compost piles and welcome clean contributions.


