Our Gospel reading this weekend turns our attention to Jesus' Instructing the disciples as he heeds their request: "teach us to pray." And I tell you, ask and you will receive; seek and you will find; knock and the door will be opened to you. ## Join The Flame of Love Prayer Cenacle!

**What is it?** It is Jesus Himself. It is a Devotion of Grace and Mary's Plan for Evangelization. What does devotion to the Flame of Love do? The effect of this devotion will make parishes, families, and the lives so full of Jesus by the power of grace, that Satan's influence on our families and communities is broken. Once freed from the blinding influence of Satan, our families and communities are much more open to the gospel and the way of salvation.

**Where did it come from?** Though many saints from Augustine to John of the Cross refer to the Flame of Love, the devotion is relatively new. In the early 1960's in Communist Hungary, Jesus and Mary introduced this devotion to a widowed mother of six and a Secular Carmelite named Elizabeth Kidemann.

**Is it Church approved?** Yes. The local ordinary, His Eminence Cardinal Peter Erdo, Primate of Hungary, established the Flame of Love Movement as a Private Association of the Faithful with Juridic Personality. The last phrase is important. Private Associations are not necessarily approved but any Association with Juridic Personality must be approved by competent ecclesiastical authority. So though the Movement was established in Budapest, the approval is for the Universal Church.

### SOCIAL JUSTICE MINISTRY CORNER

#### Education

“Our efforts at education will become inadequate and ineffectual unless we strive to promote a new way of thinking about human beings, life, society and our relationship with nature.” Pope Francis’ Laudato Si, # 215

As the oceans acidify by absorbing the carbon in the air, the basis of the food chain, phytoplankton, dies. These tiny, creatures produce more than 50% of the oxygen we breathe. Many people on the earth are already suffering because of destruction of the natural habitat. When the environment is destroyed and can no longer sustain the human populations, these people are forced to become migrants. This leads to the destabilization of governments and the outbreak of violence. As the migrant populations swell, affluent nations like our own, which produce the vast majority of the carbon, reject the climate refugees, resulting in more suffering and violence.

Let us appreciate the role we play in this dynamic, since only then can we change our behavior. Reading the science, attending community lectures on the environment, and listening to the experts are helpful steps. Because disinformation abounds, we must be discerning as to our sources, for stakeholders such as fossil fuel industries are not above using it to protect their investments. Even practices we consider praiseworthy warrant examination. Recycling of plastics is one. Its effectiveness is minimal, because just a small amount of what people think is recycled actually can be recycled and the monetary costs involved often are prohibitive. When we understand this, we then are more open to pursuing better solutions.
