ROAD TO RENEWAL ANNOUNCEMENTS

These are some bulletin announcements that have been supplied by the Diocese of Buffalo's Road to Renewal program.

Why do we need renewal now?

Our church needs to respond to the changing signs of the times and revitalize. Many factors have led us to this point and require us to renew the way we look at our parishes and how they minister to our people. The Road to Renewal is about revitalizing our parishes so that they can thrive in the future because of collaboration and cooperation. The Road to Renewal looks to bring the gifts of clergy and laity together to strengthen our mission moving forward.

Where is Jesus in the Renewal?

The Road to Renewal means that we have to take a hard look at ways in which our Diocese and parishes have not responded to the mission of Jesus. The Renewal must be about introducing people to Jesus Christ, inviting them to become missionary disciples and journeying with them on their pilgrimage towards heaven. Our Renewal must be about saving souls! All of us can be better at this and our Renewal will help in our efforts.

How does the Renewal impact my parish?

Parishes are where ministry is lived. When our parishes are strong and vibrant, our church is strong and vibrant. The Renewal's focus is to strengthen our parishes by working together to develop collaboration among parishes in a family. The Family of Parishes model allows parishes to work more collaboratively and capitalize on what each parish's strengths are. When we work together we are able to accomplish more of Jesus' mission. A Family of Parishes are parishes that are grouped together with a shared pastoral plan (mission) that they work together to accomplish. By working together resources and staffing are focused on the pastoral plan for all of the parishes within the family.

Will all parishes be affected by the Renewal?

Every parish has gifts and talents to offer. Each parish will be participating in the Renewal and will be part of a family of parishes. Since all of us are part of the Roman Catholic Church, this is an opportunity to recognize the larger church at work. When we work together, we not only share in a common mission but we make up the larger Body of Christ.

DIOCESAN COVID-19 UPDATE

Latest Interim Guidance for Parishes and its Impact on the Catholic Parishes of Fredonia

The Diocese of Buffalo has further relaxed its COVID guidelines. Holy Water fonts at the doors of the church remain empty, hymnals and other shared reusable materials are not to be in the pews, and congregational singing remains discouraged. However, there are some relaxations beyond those implemented a few weeks ago.

Vaccinations

Participation at in-person Masses and other parish events is not contingent on vaccination status, nor will individuals be questioned regarding their vaccination status or asked to produce a vaccine card.

Holy Water Fonts & Shared Materials

Baptismal fonts and holy water stoups should remain empty; hymnals and shared, reusable texts should still be absent from pews.

Singing

This guidance remains unchanged, and at this time the Diocese cannot relax any prior guidelines regarding full choirs. Congregational singing remains discouraged, with the hope that by the fall, based on progress and prudent judgment at that time, choirs may be able to return in full. Capacity & Sanitizing

At the discretion of parish leadership, reservations, pew restrictions, and other measures to limit capacity may be relaxed. However, individuals from different households are encouraged to maintain reasonable separation. Appropriate sanitizing will continue, especially for high-risk areas or frequently touched surfaces. At St. Joseph and St. Anthony Parishes, part of the sanitizing procedures involves alternating pews that are used for worship. Hence, protocols for alternating pews will continue. However, every other pew (rather than every third pew) is available now.

Masks

Masks are now optional, but may continue to be worn at the discretion of the individual. Out of pastoral concern, the safety of others should always be considered when making this choice. Ministers of the Eucharist are encouraged to continue to wear masks when distributing Communion for the protection of the vulnerable and those who may not be able to be vaccinated.

Dispensation & Livestream

As of June 6, 2021, the dispensation from the obligation to attend Mass has been lifted and all practicing Catholics should be invited to resume regular, in-person worship. To support this effort, it is suggested that live-streaming of regularly scheduled Masses be limited to one Mass per language offered per week. (Weddings, funerals, and other celebrations may still be offered to include family members who may not yet be ready to travel.)

Thank you for your continued attention to the safety and sensitivity of our people! These guidelines will continue to be periodically reviewed and updated.
